






Students Leading Students "Impaired Driving" Assembly was held on March 8th, 2024. This event took place in the west parking lot of the school where Hillman Students Leading Students, EMS, Fire, and Police emulated a crash and then all students assembled in the gym where guest Speakers; Chris Flewelling, Presque Isle Undersheriff & Ted Beck with Beck Funeral Home spoke on the repercussions of impaired driving. This Assembly is part of the S4SD Strive for a Safer Drive Campaign. As part of the campaign, SLS had to have school-wide applicability, focus on impaired driving, Incorporate S4SD branding within the campaign & also in the video, complete pre and post test for at least one traffic safety topic, complete seat belt observation survey, include at least 3 activities during the S4SD campaign, and involve the community & local media. Pre-Seat Belt Survey 11-30-23

40 students were belted

8 students were not belted

Post Seat Belt Survey 3/29/24

46 students were belted

7 students were not belted


