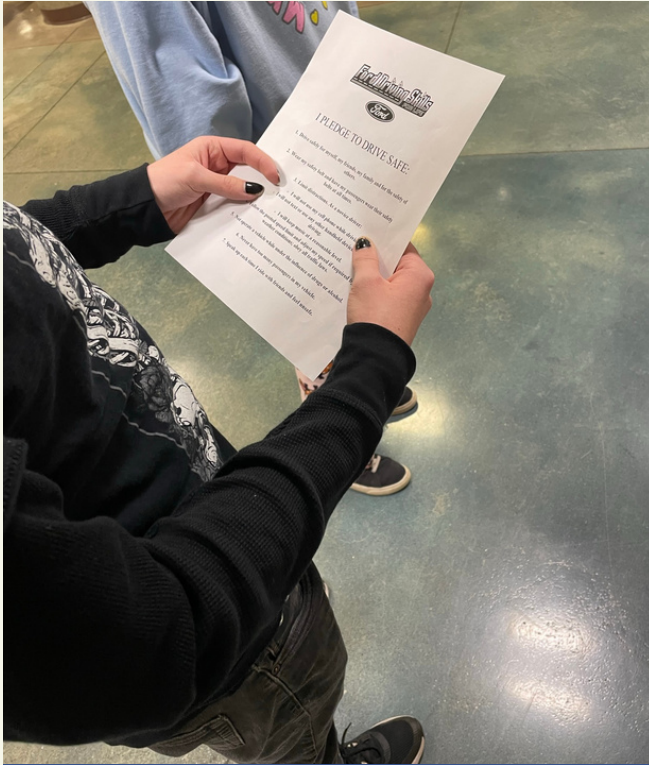

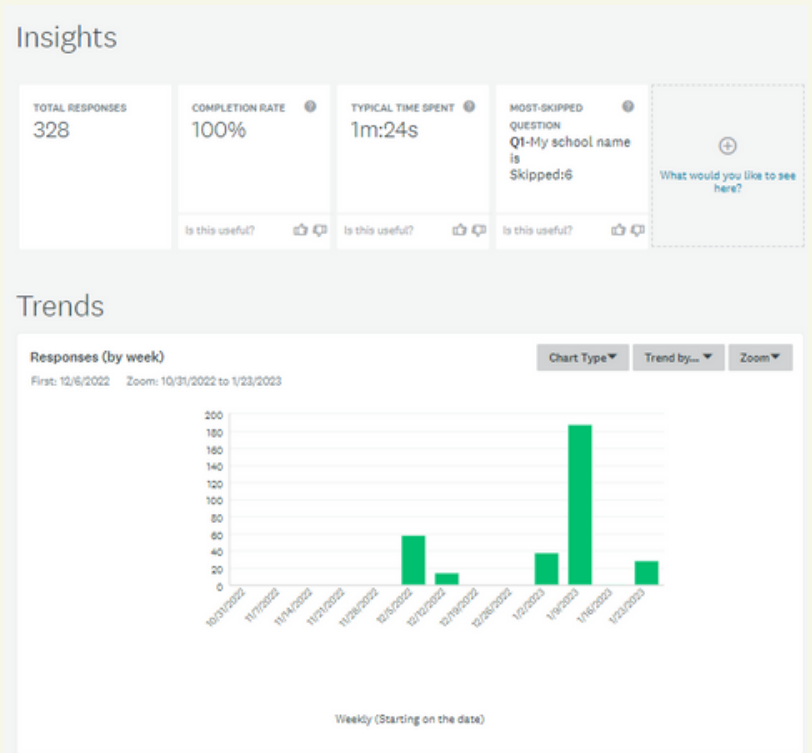

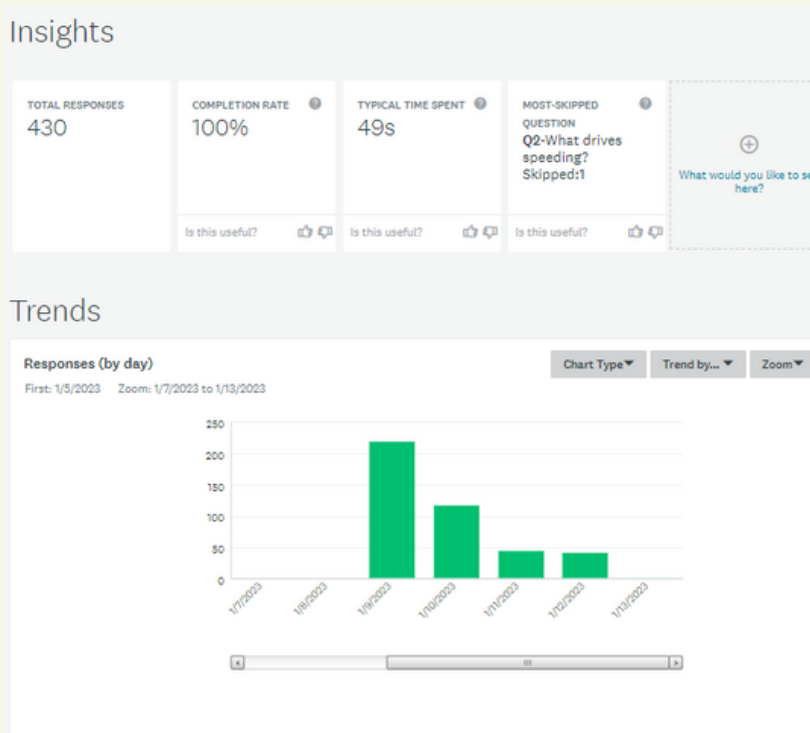
CLICK IT THE CRICKET
