## Recommendations

Secondary Road Patrol (SRP) program data is derived from reports submitted by participating sheriffs' offices as part of their reporting requirements. The data is collected on a state fiscal-year basis, October 1 through September 30, of each year.

## Coordination of Law Enforcement Agencies

Law Enforcement coordination methods range from formal written agreements identifying primary responsibility for specific functions and areas of service, to informal verbal agreements. The informal agreements usually establish operational procedures for requesting back-up support. Many sheriffs' offices have mutual aid agreements identifying the interagency resources available in the event of a major policing problem within the county. Resources may be in the form of either additional personnel or technical expertise not normally provided by smaller agencies.

The law requires each sheriff and the director of the Michigan State Police (MSP), or their authorized representative, to meet and develop a law enforcement plan for the unincorporated areas of each participating county. The law enforcement plans are reviewed and updated periodically.

In 2022, 76 sheriffs indicated involvement in county and area law enforcement associations or councils for purposes of coordinating criminal justice intelligence data, traffic problems of mutual concern, and investigative deployment in conjunction with undercover operations.

83 sheriffs reported they provided or participated in a centralized communications system, which is another form of coordination between law enforcement agencies and other public safety and emergency service providers.

The Michigan Sheriffs' Association (MSA) represents the interests of all sheriffs' offices and coordinates issues of statewide concern, based on input from its members.

## Improving Law Enforcement Coordination

Based on information provided by the counties, cooperation between state, county, and municipal agencies include reducing duplication of services and ensuring the maximum use of available resources. Some of the recommendations by participating sheriffs to improve law enforcement coordination include:

- Additional officers to maintain a high level of police presence which helps increase public safety and protection to our citizens.
- Disseminating information on incidents to other agencies in a timely manner via fax, email, and / or messenger through the mobile computer terminals in patrol units.

- Consolidating Special Response Teams, Accident Reconstruction, K-9 Teams, and other specialized units to share among county, state, and local departments.
- More joint training sessions.
- Additional meetings for sharing information.

## Improving Law Enforcement Training

Based on information provided by the county sheriffs, additional training is needed in the areas of:

- Beyond the Stop / Interdiction
- Report writing
- Commercial motor vehicles
- Pursuit Driving

## Improving Law Enforcement Communication

Based on information provided by participating sheriffs, there is a need for continued development of communication systems. Deputies in 21 counties reported being unable to communicate with their radio dispatcher from their patrol vehicle. One county reported that 99% of the county area is not reliably covered. Deputies in 30 counties reported being unable to communicate when using portable radios. One county reported that 64 percent of the county is not reliably covered. This results in a potentially hazardous environment for both law enforcement and the public. In some cases, the communication equipment purchased for the existing dispatch facilities and field units are outdated, in need of continual repair, or completely inoperable. Participating sheriffs requested the following improvements:

- Additional mobile equipment
- Additional portable equipment
- Additional system-wide equipment
- Improvement the 800-radio communication system throughout the state

## Improving Services Provided

Numerous sheriffs advised the following enhancements would improve services provided under Public Act 416 of 1978:

- Provide more funding to increase deputies and to allow for more services to residents and visitors to have safe travels while on secondary roads.
- Ability to work in troubled traffic areas more often.
- More involvement to teach young drivers at the drivers' education classes.
- Participation in community outreach programs where driving concerns are brought up.
