Any Michigan high school is encouraged to apply for Strive for a Safer Drive (S4SD). The program is a high school safe driving initiative, led by teens. Participating high schools will receive \$1,000 to create a student-led traffic safety awareness campaign. To apply, each school will need an advisor overseeing the initiative and a student(s) to take the lead.

S4SD often is organized by many organizations such as SADD, student council, leadership, criminal justice, and athletic teams. APPLICATION DEADLINE


November 10, 2023
