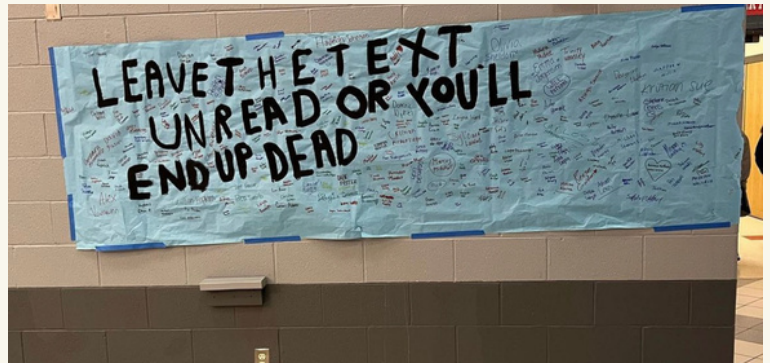

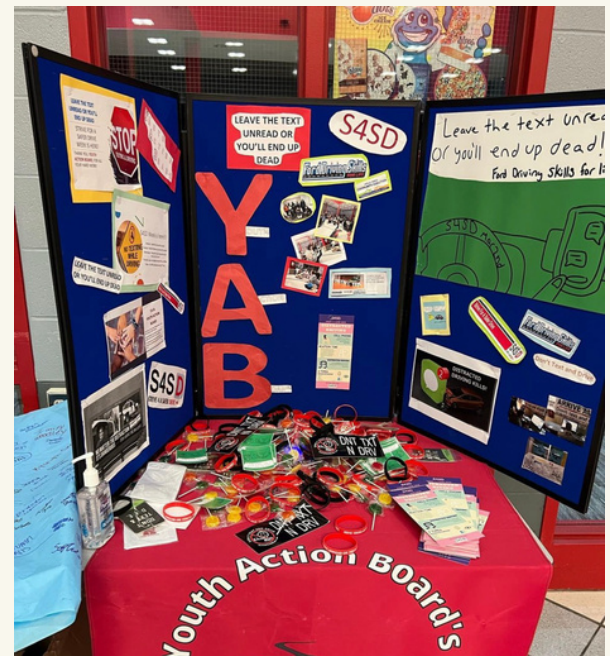
DON'T DRIVE NUTS!

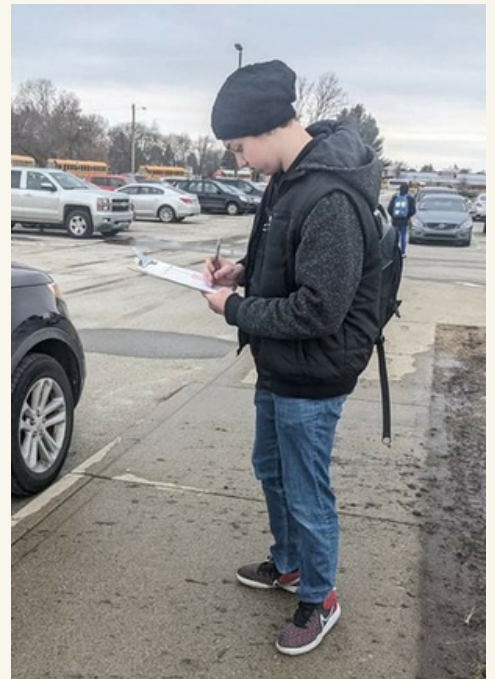
