Save the Date

The Ride and Drive events are presented by Ford Driving Skills for Life each year for S4SD participants. Students will get behind the wheel of a specially equipped vehicle on a closed course with a professional driver in the passenger seat. Instruction will cover a variety of safe driving topics including:

- Hazard Recognition: students learn the concepts of weight transfer through the pedal
 usage and directional change through steering, as well as how to avoid a crash and how
 to stay in contact with the road.
- Vehicle Handling: students learn how acceleration, deceleration, braking, and turns impact vehicle balance, as well as techniques for recovering from a skid.
- Speed and Space Management: students learn how to maintain proper space around, ahead, and behind a vehicle.
- Distracted and Impaired Driving: students learn about the dangers of texting and driving and the effects of impaired driving through driving simulators.

The Ride and Drive events will be held in late April or early May. There will be a morning and an afternoon session. Scheduling will begin as soon as the date is announced to ensure that as many students as possible are given the opportunity to attend.
