

Not later than March 30, the Office of School Safety shall provide a school safety report to the Legislature and the House and Senate fiscal agencies that must include the following:

A. The status of school safety grants, if any, issued by the Grants and Community Services Division or the Office of School Safety, including grant amounts awarded to each school district for school safety improvements.

In an effort to create safe and secure learning environments, the Michigan Legislature appropriated \$25 million for the Michigan State Police (MSP), Grants and Community Services Division (GCSD), to provide and administer competitive grants to public or nonpublic schools, school districts, and intermediate school districts (ISDs) to improve the safety and security of students, staff, and school buildings through the purchase of technology and equipment in fiscal year (FY) 2018 and in FY 2019.

The 2018 Competitive School Safety Grant Program (CSSGP) was funded from the state FY 2018 General Fund, as appropriated in 2018 PA 207, with a performance period of November 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019. The 2019 CSSGP was funded from the state FY 2019 General Fund, as appropriated in 2018 PA 618, with a performance period of March 27, 2019, through June 1, 2020. Due to issues associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, an extension through December 31, 2020, was provided to grantees to allow for the successful completion of awarded projects. Final reports for the FY 2018 and FY 2019 CSSGP were provided in the 2021 boilerplate summary.

The Michigan Legislature appropriated \$10 million for competitive grants to public schools, school districts, and ISDs for FY 2020. Due to the economic declines resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, 2020 PA 146 eliminated the \$10 million appropriation for the FY 2020 CSSGP. Therefore, no school safety grant funds were awarded.

There was no appropriation for school safety grants in FY 2021.

B. Reports of incidents of school violence or threats reported to the Department of State Police by local law enforcement or local school districts, or received through the Michigan Incident Crime Report (MICR).

School or school district self-reported incidents.

Statistics were collected from the online incident reporting system during the 2021 calendar year.

C. Reports of OK2SAY-based incidents and activities.

Activities are single tips sent into the OK2SAY tip line. Generally, when a tip is submitted, it may involve multiple communications between the individual and the OK2SAY technician. Often, these communications are counted as a single tip. An **incident** is a specific, singular event. Many individual activities can make up one incident.

For calendar year 2021, OK2SAY reported:

Activities: 6,255

Incidents: 5,650

D. Based upon an evaluation of incidents of school safety and analysis of school safety grants, recommendations on best practices and other safety measures to ensure school safety in this state.

Michigan has long been at the forefront of school safety efforts. However, more can be done to promote the continued safety of Michigan's schools.
