- September 1, 2023 Award Letters and Grant Agreement packets sent for approved applications/resubmissions.*

*MVAA must receive the Grantee signed copy of the MiVSONG Grant Agreement within 60 days of receipt of the Grant Award Packet. **Grant Agreements received after 60 days may be forfeited.**

Grant Agreements will be processed as received. Fully executed Grant Agreements will be returned to the Grantee and payment requests will be submitted.
