MVTF Director Holm reported that he and Chairperson Dempsey plan on attending the NASVDA Conference scheduled to be held in Washington DC. Director Holm reported that the first 65+ Peacetime application that was taken at the county level will be coming to the MVTF Board this February adding that a one-pager on that program is scheduled to go out as well. Director Holm indicated that the Food4Vet program will be closing soon adding that the last of the cards will be sent out to various counties in February.

#### **New Business**

MVTF Director Holm reported that Ryan Engle and he will visit the Zero Day facility for veterans located at Silver Star apartments in Battle Creek the end of next week. Director Holm also reported that the MVAA is holding a Leadership Conference in May and that all key stakeholders will be invited to attend. A brief discussion followed. MVAA Director Adams reported that there will be a Women's Veteran Leadership Conference to be held in June adding that there will be a legislative presence at this conference. Director Adams also reported that the MVAA Annual Report has been released. MVAA highlights were provided with added praise to the MVTF Board on their accomplishments assisting veterans. Director Adams reported that the Michigan Veteran Connector has been launched to identify and connect veterans to free resources to reduce veterans' suicide in Michigan and to connect veterans to the benefits they've earned. A discussion followed. MVTF Director Holm reported that the Saginaw County VSO office is on schedule to move to the new Saginaw YMCA location by the end of January. Director Holm is also planning on meeting with the Oakland County Veterans Affairs Director the end of January to address the county's needs as it relates to the MVTF.
