On Friday, September 19, MVH Chesterfield honored **POW/MIA RECOGNITION DAY** with a remembrance ceremony conducted by the **Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 284 of St Clair.**

POW ceremonies serve to recognize the sacrifices made by service members who were captured or went missing during conflicts. These events are often held on National POW/MIA Recognition Day, observed annually on the third Friday of September. The day was established to honor the commitment to achieving a full accounting of all POWs and MIAs from various wars, including the Vietnam War, Korean War, and World War II.

According to the federal government, more than 80,000 American service personnel remain missing from prior conflicts. They left their homes and families in service to our nation – and in service to each one of us – and they never made it home. Lest we forget.


