THANK YOU to everyone who supported the 5th Annual Michigan Veteran Homes at Chesterfield Heroic Walk, Run, & Roll!

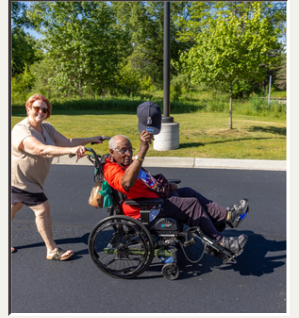

She is attentive to every change in condition and made sure concerns were addressed right away. She helped create a sense of comfort that staff appreciated. Her support was extremely helpful!

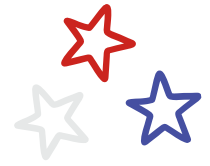
