The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) survey team conducted the 2025 Onsite VA Annual Survey of the Michigan Veteran Homes at Chesterfield Township from August 26 – 29, 2025. There were deficiencies that you were notified of in a letter dated September 25, 2025.

The revised Corrective Action Plan (CAP) you submitted was accepted and Provisional Certification issued on November 6, 2025. Per 38 C.F.R. § 51.30(a), certifications expire 600 calendar days after the date of their issuance.

The signed Attestation of Compliance indicating the Michigan Veteran Homes at Chesterfield Township is back to full compliance with all 38 C.F.R. part 51 regulations has been accepted.
