By combining engaging games with physical movement, it helps stimulate both mental and physical activity while encouraging meaningful social interaction in both group or one-on-one experiences.

Using a high-quality projector, the Tovertafel displays vibrant animations on a table surface. Participants can interact simply through hand and arm movements, making it accessible, intuitive, and enjoyable for people of varying abilities.
