Search for MVH D.J. Jacobetti Replacement Site Ongoing

While rumors have circled regarding where the future MVH D.J. Jacobetti replacement home will be located, the fact is that no final site/location has yet been determined. MVH and its partners within state government are continuing to assess several potential U.P. sites, wanting to ensure the best site for veterans in the near future, and for generations to come.

MVH Executive Director Anne Zerbe commented, "Last year, the legislature generously appropriated a significant amount of funding to replace the Jacobetti with a modern skilled nursing home: something our veterans deserve. As we move forward, it's important to us that we're in an optimal location that supports the state-of-theart facility we're constructing, as well as the lives of our veteran members."

While no site is yet chosen, the State is also awaiting information on the necessary federal grant award needed for any construction to move forward. To get an idea of what the new Jacobetti will look like, consider taking <u>a virtual tour</u> of one of our other homes. Wherever the replacement is built, it will be an incredible asset to the veterans of Michigan's Upper Peninsula.
