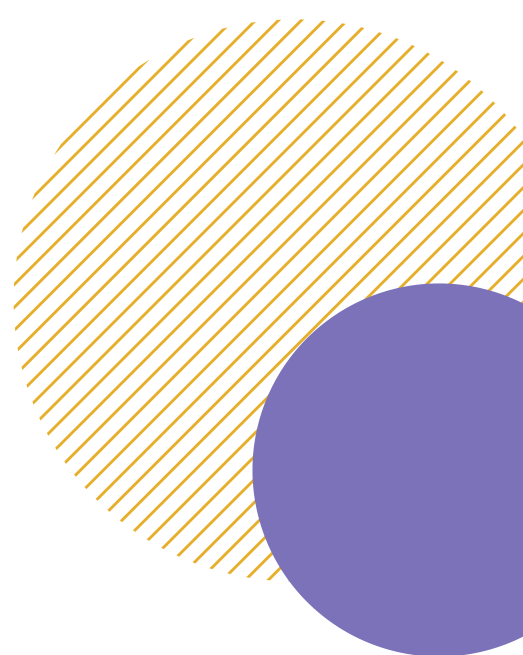

ABOUT TRI-SHARE

The MI Tri-Share Pilot (**Tri-Share**) is an **innovative** public/private partnership that equally **shares the cost of child care** between employers, employees, and the state of Michigan.

IMPLEMENTATION

- Tri-Share has expanded to cover 59 counties and the city of Detroit. Below is a list of all the regions. Our new facilitator hubs are actively recruiting interested employers in their region!

ENROLLMENT STATUS

- Since last month, five new employers have enrolled in Tri-Share. There are now **49 employers enrolled across twelve Hubs**.
- Enrolled **employers vary in size** from small to big business.
- Current enrolled employers represent **various industries**, including social assistance, agriculture, manufacturing, arts, and social and civil service orgs.
- Hubs are actively recruiting employees from participating employers. Currently there are 42 employees enrolled across three Hubs.
- Enrolled employees are receiving support for full and part-time child care as well as before and after school care for 40 children. Children range between the ages of 6 months to 11 years old.

UPDATES

- Everybody Ready will join the Tri-Share Team as a new facilitator Hub administering the program in Detroit! This now brings our total number of participating Hubs to 13!
