- 5. Who determines what they are tested for, sets the level, and "deems" the level to be safe?
- 6. What crops are most likely to be vulnerable to PFAS contamination?
- 7. If fish and wildlife being tested?
- 8. Is our food safe?
- 9. Has beef, milk, eggs and poultry been tested?
- 10. Everyone is concerned and aware of the risk that this poses to farmers. Is that part of the reluctance to test food?
- 11. What about fruits and vegetables, many of which are sprayed with herbicides and fungicides containing surfactants?
- 12. In Detroit there are many biosolids from industrial waste. How is sulfur dioxide being purified before it is sold as fertilizer?
