



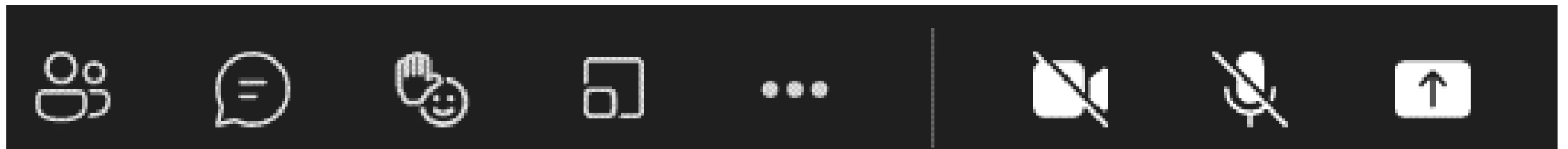

# **MPART PFAS PREVENTIVE MEASURES SUBCOMMITTEE**

**Mission Statement: To reduce/eliminate human exposure to PFAS compounds in manufacturing processes and in everyday products through legislation and community awareness of PFAS containing products. (“Turn off the tap”)**

- **Team brainstormed ways to achieve our goal providing resources and information to educate local communities and state legislators on products in the marketplace today that contain PFAS as well as products that are “PFAS-free”.**
- **Contacted various organizations and individuals, knowledgeable about PFAS-containing products requesting them to provide information/documentation to support our mission.**
- **Researched proposed Michigan legislation relating to future banning of PFAS products marketed/sold**
- **Researched multiple venues to generate a listing of specific brand names products that contain PFAS, but specific brand name information is not readily available (possibly due to product liability issues?)**
- **The goal is to provide a listing of specific websites and articles where anyone can go to educate themselves on what PFAS is and which PFAS-containing products can cause potential health issues by using those products. Suggest MPART provide a “preventive measures” tab on its website for the information.**
- **Request the CAWG and MPART provide any feedback and/or suggestions going forward**

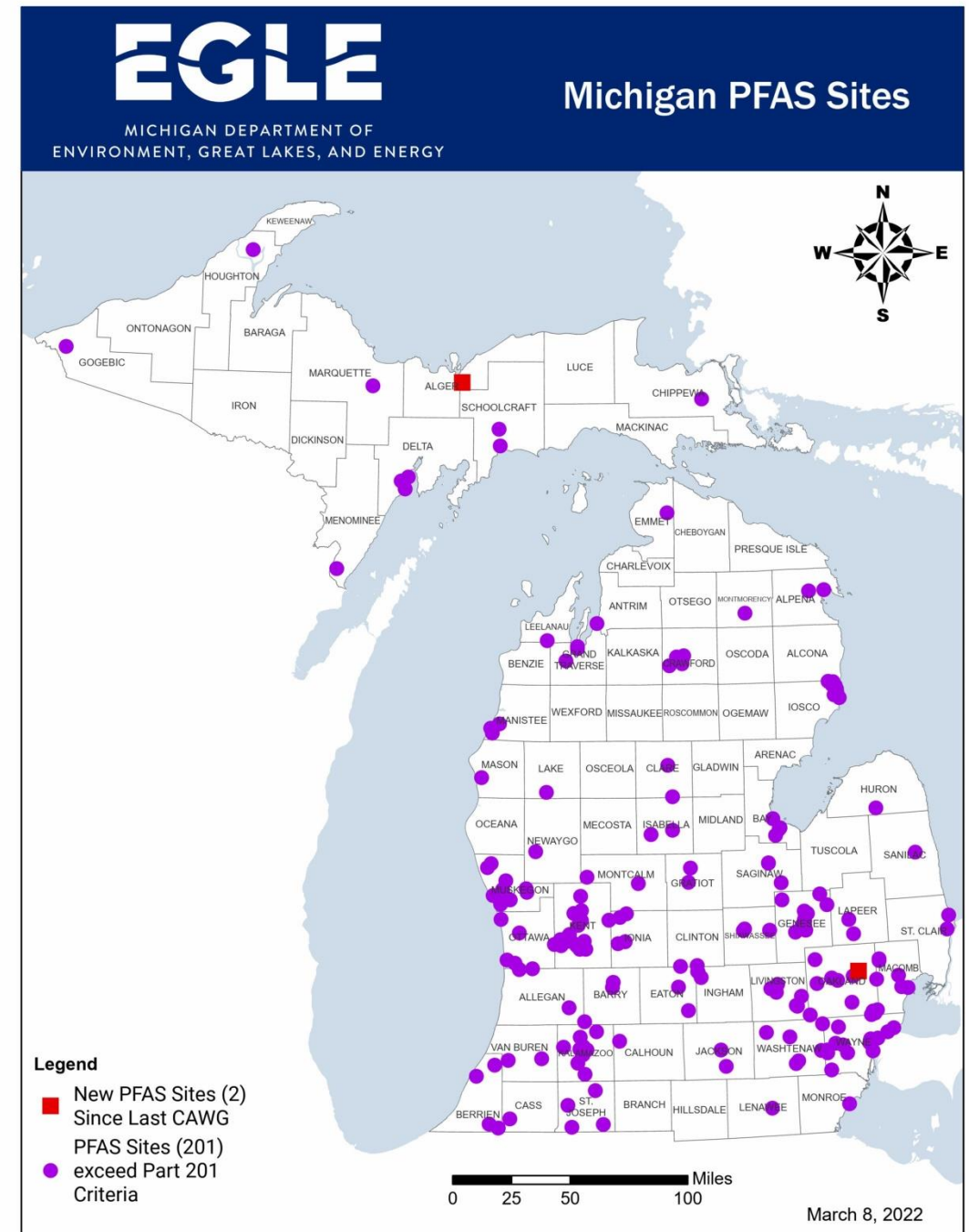
