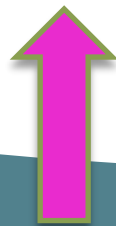
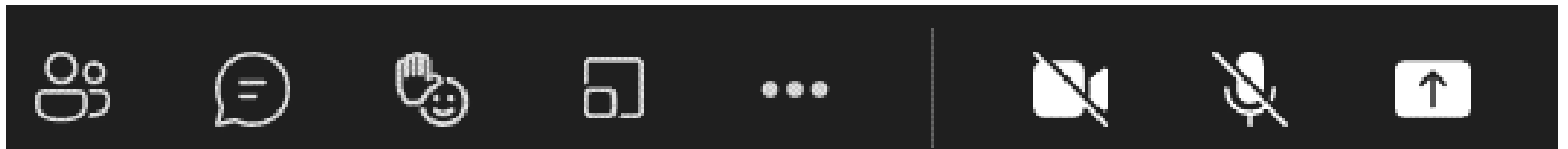

EGLE seeks suggestions for surface water quality monitoring locations

Recommendations support implementation of the Surface Water Quality Monitoring Strategy. The Strategy's primary goals are to:

- Assess the status and condition of waters of the state.
- Measure spatial and temporal water quality trends.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of water quality restoration and protection programs.
- Identify new and emerging water quality problems.

In 2023, EGLE plans to target the majority of its monitoring resources to those watersheds highlighted in the [Basin Year 5 watersheds map](#), though staff will consider recommendations for other Michigan watersheds, including the Great Lakes and connecting channels.

In order to be considered for the 2023 field season, the form needs to be completed electronically and submitted by **Oct. 30, 2022**.
