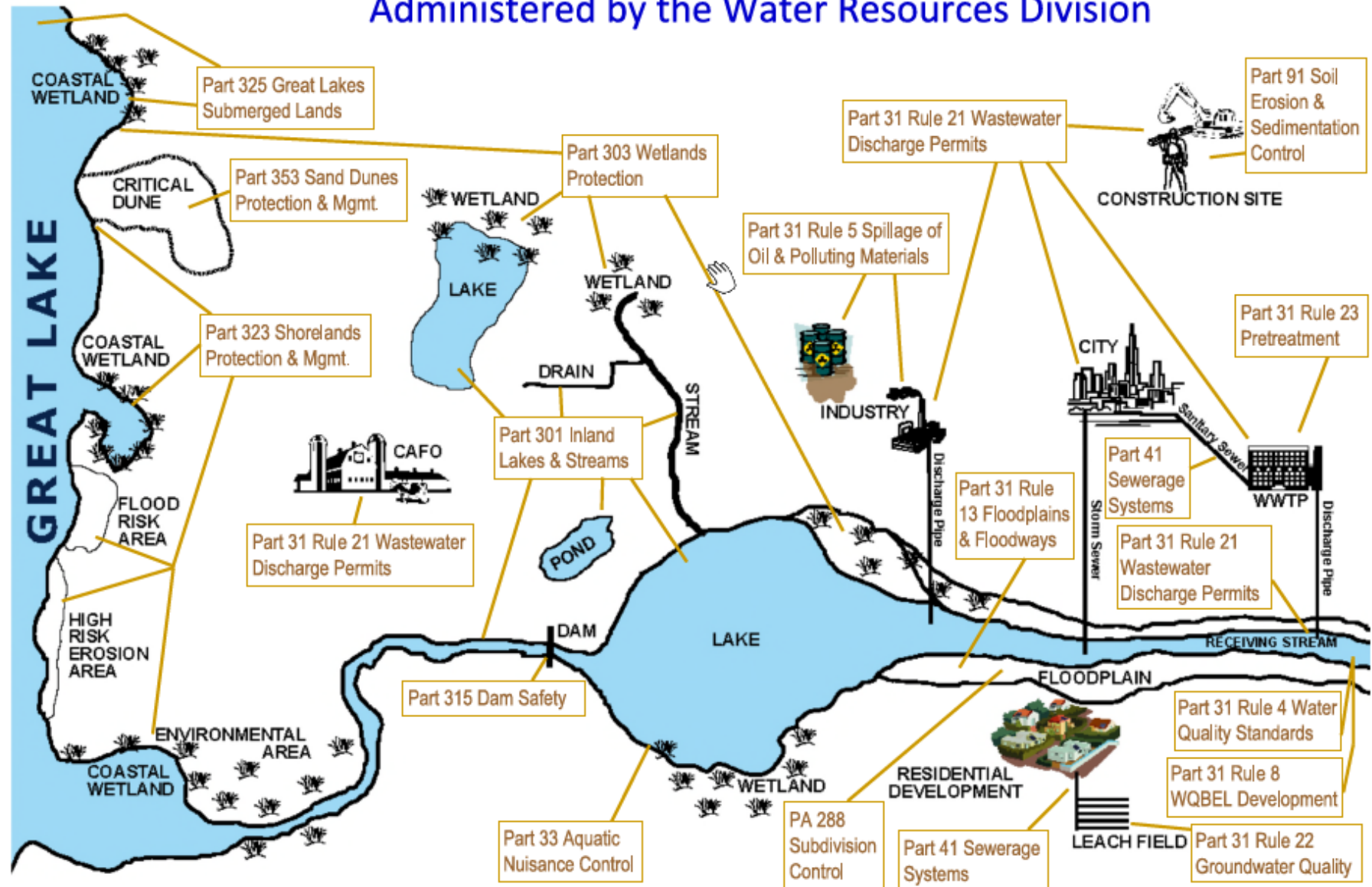

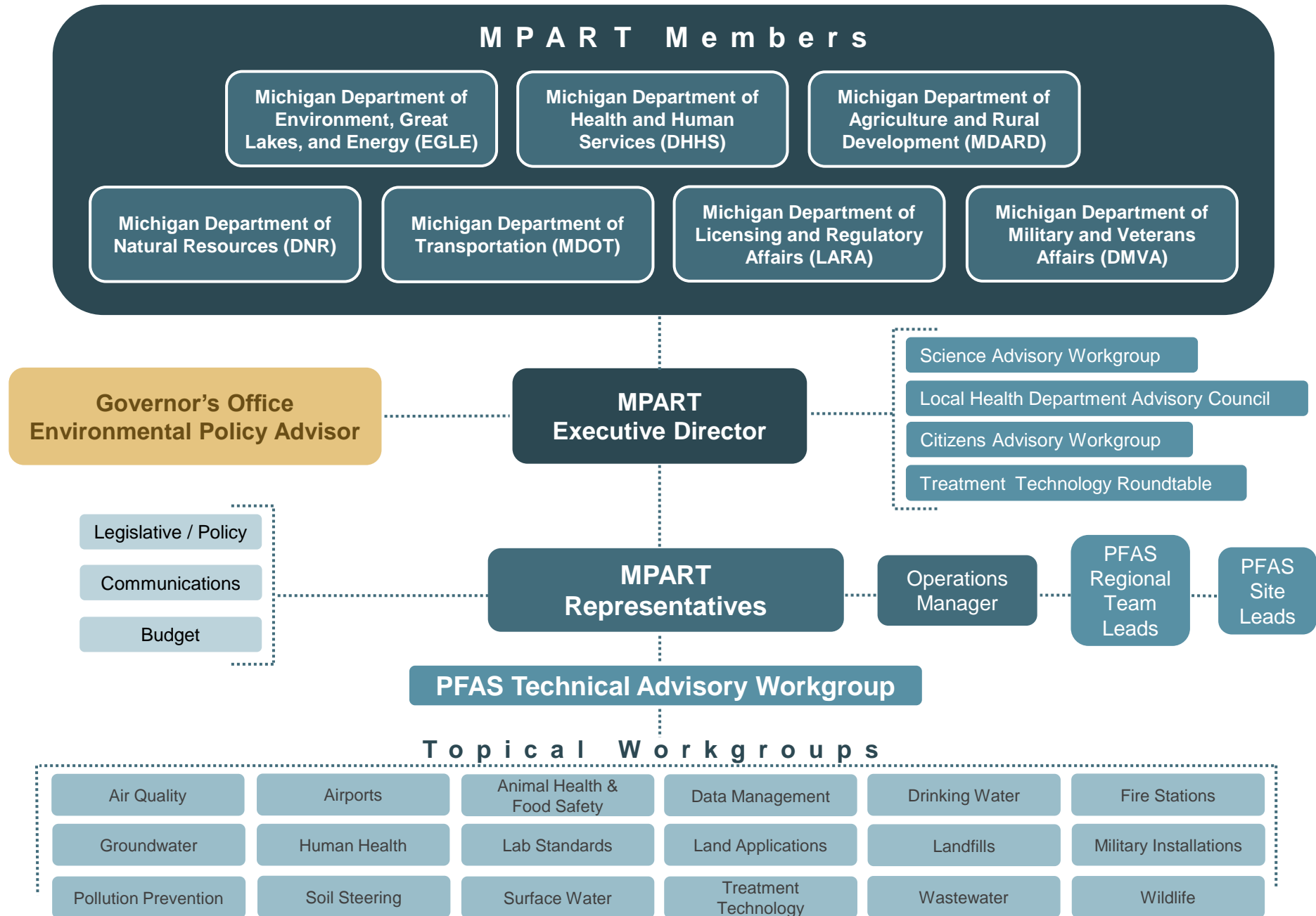


# Michigan Statutes and Rules of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as Amended Administered by the Water Resources Division

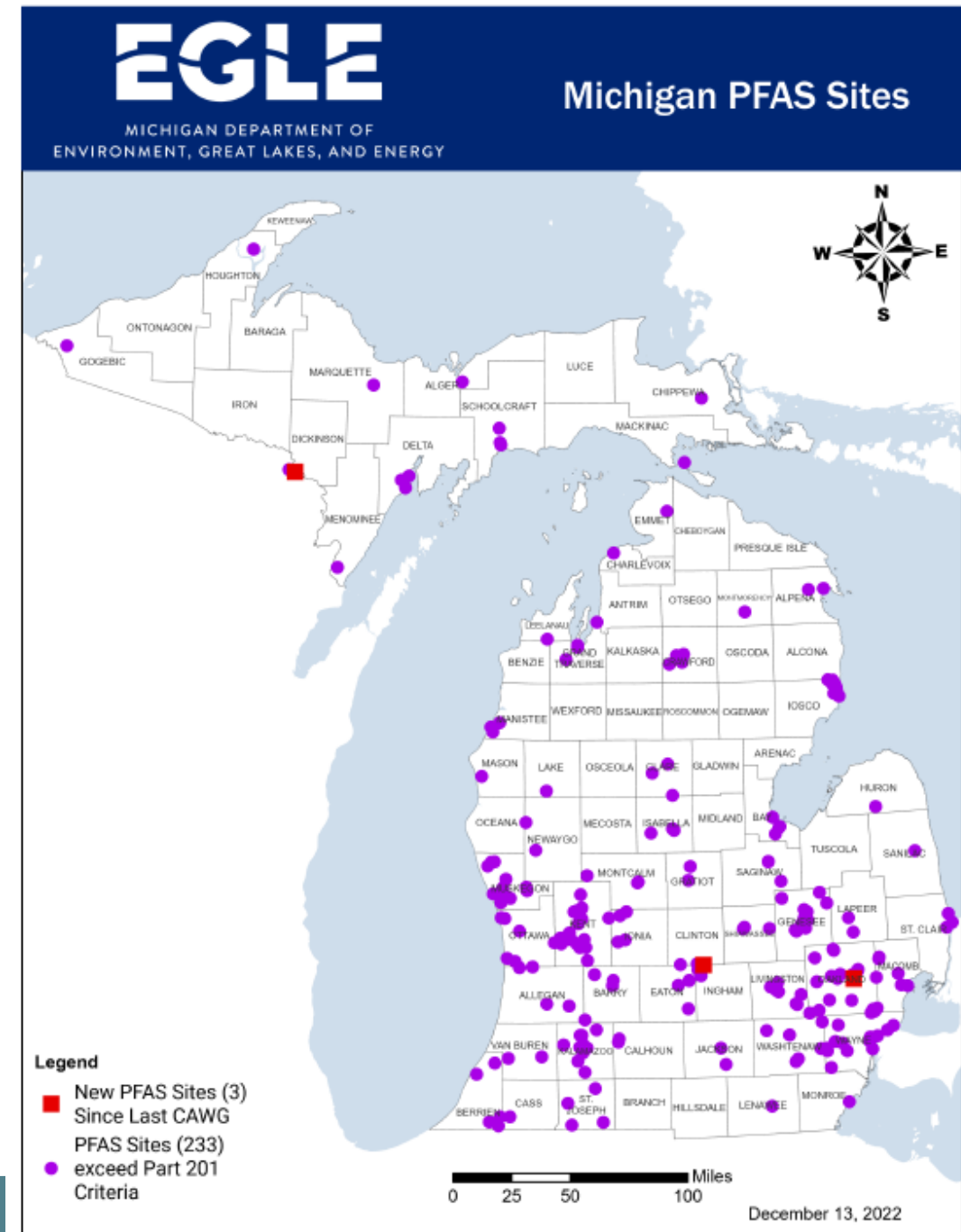
