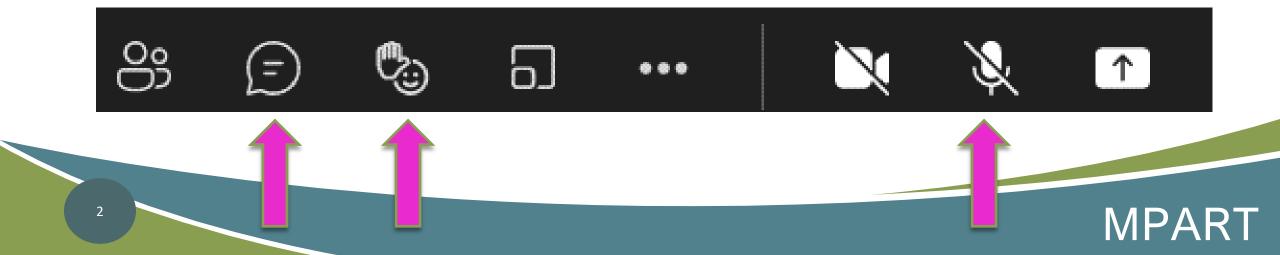

MPART Update

- EPA Method 533
 - Changing methods allows us to keep pace with EPA's methods.
 - Method 537.1
 - analyzed for 18 PFAS; 533 analyzes for 25 PFAS
 - requires extraction of samples in 14 days; 533 allows up to 28 days. Both methods require analysis of the samples within 28 days.
- Letter to EPA, USDA and FDA thanking them for their February 3 response inviting us to brief the federal interagency PFAS working group
