

PFAS Associated Health Outcomes

- Higher cholesterol
- Reduced fertility
- High blood pressure or pre-eclampsia in pregnant women
- Small decreases in infant birth weight

- Thyroid disease
- Liver damage
- Decreased immune system response to vaccines
- Developing certain types of cancer


