EGLE RRD - former WAFB

- After RAB, EGLE met with NOW (Need Our Water) group and Au Sable Township. EGLE plans to have additional meetings in advance (a few weeks to a month) of future RABs
- Overview of BCT and Vapor Intrusion meetings with Air Force this week
- Continuing Review of Weapons Storage area restrictive Covenant

USAF former WAFB

- Discussed that Matt Marrs is retiring at the end of September and thanked him for his hard work on Wurtsmith.
 - o EGLE also appreciated Matt's efforts and help on Wurtsmith
- Discussed status of the Mission Street Groundwater Treatment System
 - Demolition
 - o Air stripper stacks will be sampled for disposal purposes.
 - Finalizing design on Mission Street plant
 - o Oscoda Township discussed the use of storm water system and user fee for effluent
 - AF to follow up with Oscoda Township
- Draft ESI Report from USAF Consultant to USAF for review in October.
 - USAF will keep EGLE updated
- Current groundwater treatment systems working normally.
- Next RAB is tentatively planned for December 2019 with new system. RAB date may be moved due to holidays, weather, etc. Updates and specific dates to come.

EGLE RRD Bay City District Office-Oscoda Area

- Plan to sample 20 monitoring wells in Oscoda and Au Sable Township. Planning to complete work in October.
- Also starting investigation work in Au Sable Township, also in October.

EGLE WRD, former WAFB- and Oscoda Area updates

No updates. Waiting on analytical from recent sampling inspection.

MDNR

- Permanent signs to be installed by October 1 (Deer health advisory).
- Making progress on Fall sampling of deer.
- Still working out potential sampling of waterfowl. Evaluating the science on how to properly sample waterfowl.

USDA-FS

- Received final draft of PASI report for Clark's Marsh. Currently report is in internal review.
- Asked MDNR for clarification on health advisory, specifically regarding eating beavers.
 MDNR responded that it falls under the general health advisory.

MDHHS

- Working with Roscommon office to install the approximately 50 health advisory signs prior to deer bow hunting season.
- MDHHS has met with NOW group to discuss possible exposure assessment late next year. Will start meeting with community members in January.
- Coordinating with DHD2 for health care provider outreach on PFAS.

DHD2

- Working with MDHHS on health care provider education/outreach, looking for State leadership on how to standardize with the Biomonitoring grant awarded to the State.
- Changes in groundwater MCLs for PFAS may increase desire from community members.
- ASTDR grant money would not cover an assessment in Oscoda. Funds would be sourced from the State.

OWAA

 Phase I and II Site assessments (funded through EGLE Brownfield Redevelopment Funds) on hanger development sites complete and waiting on analytical data as well as reporting from their consultant.

Oscoda Township

- Analytical results from lagoon system samples taken on August 27th consistent with previous results.
- Need to test further "upstream" to determine source before contending with biosolids.
- EGLE Water Resources Division has reviewed sampling work plan and will be updating Oscoda Township soon.

Au Sable Township

• Au Sable Township Thank EGLE and MPART for meeting on and appreciate all info that has been shared with the Township.

Community RAB

- Proactively engaging past month with MPART on MCL process.
- Submitted comments specifically for PFHxS MCL to be 51, based on New Hampshire report.
- Submitted request to EGLE that language be added to the draft that all Stakeholders review draft prior to being passed in 6 months.
- EGLE clarified that new MCLs don't apply to surface water. Only groundwater.
- Will be communicating with the AF regarding clarification of the \$66 million allocated for PFAS sites. There was confusion on the messaging of this RAB slide.
