

MPART EXECUTIVE ORDER FISCAL YEAR 2021 FAST FACTS

The **Michigan PFAS Action Response Team (MPART)** was created within the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) by the Governor's office under Executive Order (EO) 2019-03. The EO established MPART as an enduring advisory body to address the threat of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substance (PFAS) contamination in Michigan. MPART is tasked with protecting public health and ensuring the safety of Michigan's land, air, and water, while facilitating interagency coordination, increasing transparency, and requiring clear standards to ensure accountability.

Below are actions taken in fiscal year (FY) 2021 by the following seven agencies that comprise MPART:

- **Department of Natural Resources**
- **Department of Agriculture and Rural Development**
- **Department of Transportation**
- **Department of Military and Veterans Affairs**
- **Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs**

Clean Drinking Water/Protected Public Health

2,700 public water supplies monitored under the Safe Drinking Water Act

49 new MPART sites identified - nearby residential wells sampled

440 residential wells sampled

1,682 residential wells resampled

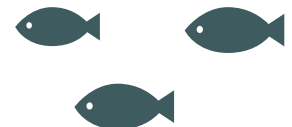
157 filter systems provided, **490** replacement cartridges

6 drinking water infrastructure grants awarded totaling **\$16.9M**

1 drinking water loan for **\$1.48M**

723 samples collected from lakes and streams

878 fish collected for PFAS analysis

7 fire departments participating in the PFAS in Firefighters of Michigan (PFOMS) project



Investigations and Sampling

7 new hazardous waste site investigations started

9 new solid waste landfill site investigations started

165 biosolids samples collected from 157 wastewater treatment plants (WWTPs)

44 WWTPs sampled for influent, effluent, and sludge

28 permitted discharges sampled

28 industrial inspections done to pinpoint sources of PFAS

Increased Transparency and Communication

1,650 attendees at EGLE's 2020 Great Lakes PFAS Summit

29 townhalls and 8 training webinars reaching over 4,156 people

47 calls with local officials for MPART sites

Numerous presentations to local, state, and federal partners about MPART

All 16 topical workgroup summaries updated online

Twice-weekly calls to coordinate across the 7 MPART departments
