- 1. Read the enclosed plan summary to learn more about your retirement plan, including how service credit affects your retirement plan. Research your options carefully before making your election.
- 2. Return the election form to ORS by January 31, 2020, 5 p.m. EST.
- 3. When we receive your election form, we'll send you a confirmation letter. If you choose to add this prior service to your public school retirement account, we'll also send you a bill for the amount of contributions and interest needed for your service credit.
- 4. Review and pay your contributions by **June 30, 2020, 5 p.m. EDT**. ORS will credit your account with your service credit after payment is received.

This is a one-time election and it is irrevocable.

If ORS doesn't receive your election form and full payment by the deadline, your opportunity to add your prior service will no longer be available.
