## MICHIGAN RECONNECT EXPANSION

Michigan Reconnect has expanded to temporarily lower the eligibility age from 25 to 21!

Now Michigan residents ages 21-24, including already enrolled community college students, can earn a degree or skill certificate, tuition-free.



## **Am I Eligible?**

To be eligible for the Michigan Reconnect expansion, students must:

- Be at least **21 years of age** and not more than **24** years of age.
- Apply and enroll in a community or tribal college no later than summer semester 2025.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- Have lived in Michigan for at least a year.
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent or certificate of completion.
- Have not yet completed a college degree.

## How Can I Keep the Ball Rolling?

To maintain eligibility, students must meet all of the following conditions for the Reconnect Program:

- Continue to **be a Michigan resident**.
- **Maintain enrollment** in a Pell-eligible program at a community or tribal college leading to an associate degree or industry-recognized certificate or credential.
- Earn at least 12 credits each academic year, once the individual begins coursework.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as determined by the institution or a cumulative 2.0 GPA since becoming a Michigan Reconnect scholarship recipient.
- File the FAFSA each academic year.
