Waterloo-Pinckney Hiking Trail is open to hunting during established seasons.

Trail is closed to bikes west of the Potawatomi Trail (at intersection #12) in Pinckney Recreation Area.

Camping is allowed only in designated areas: Blind Lake (no ground fires, backpack stoves only) and Crooked Lake Campground. Permits are required.

Recreation Passport required for vehicle entry at all locations.

Waterloo-Pinckney hiking trail is closed to bikes in the Waterloo Recreation Area.

Camping is allowed only in designated areas; Portage Lake, Sugarloaf Lake, Horseman's Campground, Green Lake, and the Pines campground (no water, no ground fires).

The following cabins are available to rent: Camper Cabin, Burns 1 & 2, Southfork, Mill Lake and Green Lake Yurt. Please Note: The Pines, Green Lake and the Horseman's Campgrounds are not reservable.
