

## Notice to Use MET Education Benefits

Issued under Public Act 316 of 1986

**The Beneficiary (Student) may activate their MET from their online account or they may complete this form, sign, and submit to MET.** Use this notice if you will be **attending a Michigan public university or a Michigan community college**. Submit by June 1 or at least three months prior to the semester you plan to use the benefits to ensure timely receipt of MET benefits. **Allow two to four weeks for processing.**

Schools which are on a block rate credit hour system will invoice MET for the block rate, but report the actual number of credits taken by the student. **Block rate schools will NOT bill MET for a portion of the credits you are enrolled in.**

**Full Benefits Contracts:** Provide undergraduate tuition and mandatory fees\*\* at every Michigan public 4-year university. At a Michigan public community college, it provides tuition, contact/billing hour fees and mandatory fees (in-state or in-district) up to the average tuition of Michigan public four-year universities.

**Limited Benefits Contracts:** Provide undergraduate tuition and mandatory fees\*\* at Michigan public universities whose tuition costs do not exceed 105% of the weighted average tuition cost of Michigan's four-year public schools. Full tuition benefits would not be covered at schools with tuition costs greater than 105% of the weighted average tuition. Rather, only a percentage of the tuition benefits would be provided for students attending those schools. At a Michigan public community college, it provides tuition, contact/billing hour fees and mandatory fees (in-state or in-district) up to the average tuition of Michigan public four-year universities. For the 2026-27 academic year, MET Limited Benefit contracts will cover 28 of 30 credit hours at University of Michigan, Ann Arbor campus, 26 of 30 credits at Michigan Technological University, and 29 of 30 credits hours at Oakland University. The remaining Michigan public universities will be covered credit for credit.

**Community College Contracts:** Provide **in-district** tuition and mandatory fees\*\* when attending a Michigan community college.

\*\*Mandatory fees are those which all enrolled students are required to pay. Fees **not** covered include: application fees, health care fees, contact hour fees and fees which are course specific (such as lab fees for science and computer classes, etc.), or fees assessed based on the number of credit hours enrolled.

NOTE: Contracts purchased 2013 through 2019 may need to submit form 5714 Agreement to Amend a MET Contract (Mandatory Fees). Without this form MET is capped at the amount of mandatory fees we can pay (capped at 2012 rates). Purchasers who submit this form will have the cap removed from their contracts. This form must be notarized, and the original must be mailed to MET. **MET will notify the Purchaser and Beneficiary if submission of form 5714 is required.**
