When you apply for a driver's license or state ID, you have the opportunity to join the Michigan Organ Donor Registry.

Joining the **Michigan Organ Donor Registry** means that upon your death, you agree to become an organ, eye and tissue donor to save up to 8 lives, and potentially heal up to 125 others.

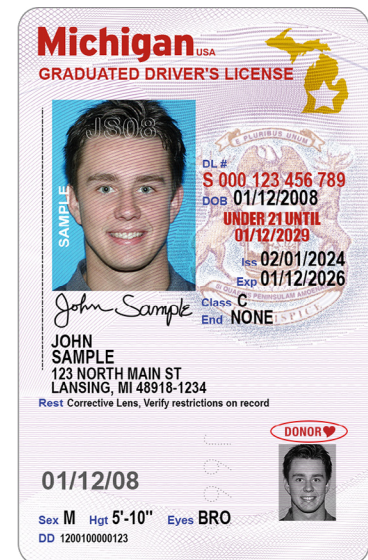
It's important to share your decision with your loved ones.

Note: This registration is a binding, legal document of your generous gift. This is referred to as [First-person Authorization](#).

A few facts about organ donation

- Up to 3,000 patients in Michigan are waiting for an organ transplant, and over 100,000 are waiting nationally.
- Most major religions support donation.
- Don't rule yourself out for health reasons. Medical experts decide which organs and tissues, if any, are healthy enough to help others.
- There is no age limit for organ and tissue donation.
- Organ donation is not considered until every effort to save the patient's life has been exhausted.
- There is no cost to the donor or their family.
- A majority of Michiganders – 4.6 million – are registered organ donors.
