



Detail of "union bug" for Canfora Campaign Mailer (EXHIBIT 2)



Dear Ms. Bourbonais:

I have been retained by the Friends of Chonganna Canfora committee to respond to the recent complaints filed by Gideon D'Assandro on behalf of the Michigan Freedom Fund. The complaints allege that the committee improperly spent public funds, provided rides to the polls for voters, and failed to provide required identification on one of its pieces of campaign literature.

As stated in your letter of August 14, the first two complaints have been summarily dismissed by the Department of State. As for the remaining issue, the committee agrees that the item of campaign literature that was the subject of the complaint did not include the required identification. By way of remedial action the committee has:

- Sent a message by email to all of the contacts known to the committee identifying the item of literature and stating that the item of literature was indeed paid for by the committee. A copy of the email message is included with this letter.
- Issued a press release to local media identifying the item of literature and stating that the item of literature was indeed paid for by the committee. A copy of the press release is included with this letter.

The committee would welcome the opportunity to meet with the Department in a conciliation conference to conclude this matter. Please contact me for scheduling at your earliest convenience.

Chong-Anna Canfora Issues Statement Regarding Campaign Literature Piece

Dear Mr. McRae:

The Department of State (Department) has completed its investigation of a complaint filed against Chong-Anna Canfora by Gideon D'Assandro, which alleged that Ms. Canfora violated section 47(1) of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.247(1), by failing to include a complete and correct identification statement on certain campaign-related material. This letter concerns the disposition of Mr. D'Assandro's complaint.

The MCFA and corresponding administrative rules require a person who produces printed material that relates to an election to include the phrase "Paid for by [name and address of the person who paid for the item]." MCL 169.247(1), R 169.36(2). A knowing violation constitutes a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000.00, imprisonment for up to 93 days, or both. MCL 169.247(5).

The Act also requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further violation by using informal methods [,]" if it finds that "there may be reason to believe that a violation ... has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). The objective of an informal resolution is "to correct the violation or prevent a further violation [.]" *Id*.

The complaint was filed by Mr. D'Assandro on August 7, 2013, and you filed a written response on August 26, 2013. Mr. D'Assandro did not file a rebuttal statement.

Mr. D'Assandro alleged that a piece of Ms. Canfora's campaign literature, which stated "We need a change at City Council [,]" "Vote Tuesday, August 6th 2013 [,]" and "Chong-Anna Canfora Lansing City Council, 4th Ward [,]" did not contain a paid-for-by statement.

In response, you filed a letter which stated that "the committee agrees that the item of campaign literature that was the subject of the complaint did not include the required identification." You further stated that the committee sent an email message to the contacts known to the committee and issued a press release to the local media, both stating that the item was paid for by the committee.

While the Department believes that the evidence tends to show that this particular piece of Ms. Canfora's campaign material failed to contain a paid-for-by statement, section 15(10) of the MCFA requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further

violation by using informal methods such as a conference, conciliation, or persuasion [.]" The Department is satisfied that Ms. Canfora took appropriate corrective measures.

Additionally, the Department is advising Ms. Canfora that section 47(1) of the Act and R 169.36(2) require a candidate to print a complete and accurate identification statement on all campaign materials, consisting of the phrase "paid for by" followed by the full name and address of the candidate committee. Note that all printed materials that refer to an election or Ms. Canfora's candidacy produced in the future must include this identification statement.

Should Ms. Canfora choose to run for office again, please be advised that this notice has served to remind her of her obligation under the Act to identify her printed matter, and may be used in future proceedings as evidence that tends to establish a knowing violation of the Act. A knowing violation is a misdemeanor offense and may merit referral to the Attorney General for enforcement action. MCL 169.247(5), 215(10).

The Department now considers this matter closed and will take no further action against Ms. Canfora at this time.
