Dear Ms. Brandana:

The Department of State (Department) received a formal complaint filed against you by Charles Johnson, alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 et seq. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 et seq. A copy of the complaint and supporting documentation are enclosed with this letter.

The MCFA requires filed campaign finance statements and reports to be timely, complete, and accurate. MCL 169.233. The MCFA requires a committee that receives or expends more than \$1,000.00 during any reporting period to file periodic campaign finance reports in compliance with the Act. MCL 169.233(6). The failure to file a single campaign statement may trigger the assessment of late filing fees, while the failure to file two or more campaign statements is a misdemeanor offense. MCL 169.233(7)-(8). A candidate or treasurer who knowingly files an incomplete or inaccurate statement or report may be subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000.00. MCL 169.233(10). A candidate or treasurer who knowingly omits or underreports a contribution or expenditure may be subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000.00, or the amount of the undisclosed contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater. MCL 169.233(11).

Mr. Johnson alleges that the three campaign finance statements that you filed on May 14, 2013 were filed late and are incomplete and inaccurate. In particular, Mr. Johnson alleges that your statements do not reflect correct beginning and ending balances. Additionally, Mr. Johnson alleges that your Pre-Primary Campaign Statement filed on August 13, 2008 failed to report a contribution made on June 24, 2008 from the UAW Michigan Voluntary PAC, as reported on its 2008 July Triannual Statement and Amended 2008 July Triannual Statement. Finally, Mr. Johnson alleges that your statements do not reflect the refund made to IAFF Local 1252 in the amount of \$4,500.00.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true.

If you wish to file a written response to this complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the

Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 430 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

A copy of your reply will be provided to Mr. Johnson, who will have an opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement to the Department. After reviewing all of the statements and materials provided by the parties, the Department will determine whether "there may be reason to believe that a violation of [the MCFA] has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). Note that the Department's enforcement powers include the possibility of entering a conciliation agreement, conducting an administrative hearing, or referring this matter to the Attorney General for enforcement of the criminal penalty provided in section 33(8) of the Act.



Pursuant to Section 15(10) of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (the Act), 1976 P.A. 388, as amended; MCL 169.201 et seq., the Secretary of State and the Committee to Elect Jill Brandana (Respondent) hereby enter into a conciliation agreement with respect to certain acts, omissions, methods, or practices prohibited by the Act.

The Secretary of State alleges that there may be reason to believe that the Respondent violated Section 52(1)(c) of the Act by accepting two contributions from the Taylor Fire Fighters PAC Fund that exceed the statutory contribution limit of \$500.00.

Therefore, the Respondent, without admitting any issue of law or fact, except as stated herein, hereby voluntarily enters into this conciliation agreement and assures the Secretary of State that it will comply with the Act and the Rules promulgated to implement the Act.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that this agreement is in effect and enforceable for four years from the date it is signed by the Secretary of State or her duly authorized representative.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that this agreement, unless violated, shall constitute a complete bar to any further action by the Secretary of State with respect to the alleged violation that resulted in this agreement.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that the referral and investigation that resulted in this agreement are disposed of and will not be the basis for further proceedings, except pursuant to this agreement.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that this agreement will not prevent the Secretary of State from taking action for violations of this agreement.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that the Respondent's performance under this agreement shall be given due consideration in any subsequent proceedings.

The Secretary of State and the Respondent further agree that this agreement, when signed, shall become a part of the permanent public records of the Department of State.

Please allow this letter to serve as my formal response to your correspondence dated October 2, 2013 (received by me October 7, 2013).

First, and foremost, at no time did I ever file a false campaign statement. On May 13, 2013, I filed four campaign statements based on all available documentation in my possession. My campaign statements were delayed due to the fact that my Campaign Treasurer became critically ill and was hospitalized many (approximately 6-8) times during 2008 and 2009. My Treasurer's illness resulted in her losing her job where she was Treasurer of a political organization (on and off) since 1975. During her extensive illness, I was unable to retrieve all the necessary documentation to prepare my reports. (See attached Affidavit.) These unforeseen delays resulted in my Campaign paying fines in excess of \$4,000.

On May 13, 2013, I filed all outstanding reports, which I believed had corrected all outstanding errors and omissions. On October 8, 2013, I received several error and omissions Notices from the State. This was my first notice that any such errors remained since my May 13, 2013 filing. All remaining errors or omissions per the notice of October 8, 2013 will be corrected and submitted to the State by the due date.

This is yet another attempt of this former (laid-off) City of Taylor employee to harass me. Mr. Johnson harasses me at City Council meetings, and follows me around with my name on his van. It is my belief that he is frustrated that he fell just short of being eligible to qualify for a lifetime health care.

I look forward to resolving all outstanding campaign finance issues, so I may finally close this Campaign. I thank you for your time and consideration.

Dear Ms. Brandana:

The Department of State (Department) has completed its initial investigation of the campaign finance complaint filed against you by Charles Johnson, alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 et seq. This letter concerns the disposition of Mr. Johnson's complaint, which was filed on September 23, 2013. You filed an answer to the complaint on October 23, 2013. Mr. Johnson did not file a rebuttal statement with the Department.

Mr. Johnson alleged that the three campaign finance statements cover the reporting periods from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 and January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012 that you filed on May 14, 2013 were filed late and were incomplete and inaccurate. In particular, Mr. Johnson alleged that your statements do not reflect correct beginning and ending balances. Additionally, Mr. Johnson alleged that your Pre-Primary Campaign Statement filed on August 13, 2008 failed to report a contribution made on June 24, 2008 from the UAW Michigan Voluntary PAC, as reported on its 2008 July Triannual Statement and Amended 2008 July Triannual Statement. Finally, Mr. Johnson alleged that your statements do not reflect the refund made to IAFF Local 1252 in the amount of \$4,500.00.

The MCFA requires filed campaign finance statements and reports to be timely, complete, and accurate. MCL 169.233. The MCFA requires a committee that receives or expends more than \$1,000.00 during any reporting period to file periodic campaign finance reports in compliance with the Act. MCL 169.233(6). The failure to file a single campaign statement may trigger the assessment of late filing fees, while the failure to file two or more campaign statements is a misdemeanor offense. MCL 169.233(7)-(8). A candidate or treasurer who knowingly files an incomplete or inaccurate statement or report may be subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000.00. MCL 169.233(10). A candidate or treasurer who knowingly omits or underreports a contribution or expenditure may be subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000.00, or the amount of the undisclosed contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater. MCL 169.233(11).

The MCFA also requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further violation by using informal methods [,]" if it finds that "there may be reason to believe that a violation ... has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). The objective of an informal resolution is "to correct the violation or prevent a further violation [.]" *Id*.

#### Late-Filed Statements

In your answer, you state that your "campaign statements were delayed due to the fact that [your] Campaign Treasurer became critically ill and was hospitalized many (approximately 6-8) times during 2008 and 2009." You also provided an affidavit from Mary Culberson, which states that Ms. Culberson was the treasurer of your committee in 2008 and 2009 and that she became critically ill in January, 2009 and hospitalized on multiple occasions in 2009.

First, the Department notes that MCL 169.221(8) provides that when "[w]hen the office of treasurer in a candidate committee is vacant, the candidate shall be the treasurer until the candidate appoints a new treasurer." If Ms. Culberson was unable to perform her duties as treasurer, you were required to assume those duties. Under MCL 169.222, those duties included the keeping of detailed accounts, records, bills, and receipts to substantiate the information on your reports.

A review of your committee's filings indicates that you have late-filed every report due by your committee since its formation. Your 2008 Annual campaign statement was filed 12 days late, for which you paid a \$200.00 late-filing fee; your 2008 Pre-Primary campaign statement was filed 19 days late, for which you paid a \$725.00 late-filing fee; your 2008 Post-Primary campaign statement was filed 2 days late; for which you paid a \$25.00 late-filing fee; your 2009 Annual campaign statement was filed 5 days late, for which you paid a \$100.00 late-filing fee; your 2010 Annual campaign statement was filed 3 years, 3 months, and 13 days late, for which you paid a \$1,000.00 late-filing fee; your 2011 Annual campaign statement was filed 2 years, 3 months, and 14 days late, for which you paid a \$1,000.00 late-filing fee, your 2012 Annual campaign statement remains unfiled and the associated \$1,000.00 late-filing fee remains unpaid; and your 2013 Annual campaign statement was filed 108 days late, and while no fee has yet been assessed, you are also subject to a \$1,000.00 late-filing fee for this statement.

In addition you signed, as Treasurer of your committee, a Conciliation Agreement with the Department on December 8, 2009 (signed by the Department on December 15, 2009 completing the agreement), in which you assured the Secretary of State that you would comply with the Act and the rules promulgated to implement the Act. It appears that you violated this agreement on February 1, 2010 -- just 48 days after the Conciliation Agreement went into effect -- when you failed to file your 2010 Annual Statement in a timely manner.

#### **Undisclosed Contribution**

Your answer did not specifically address Mr. Johnson's allegation that you failed to report a contribution to your committee made on June 24, 2008 by the UAW Michigan Voluntary PAC. This contribution appears on the UAW Michigan Voluntary PAC's 2008 Triannual Statement and Amended 2008 July Triannual Statement. You have stated that during Ms. Culberson's illness, you were "unable to retrieve all the necessary documentation to prepare [your] reports." Ms. Culberson's Affidavit indicates that important documentation from your campaign was lost during Ms. Culberson's illness and her extended absence from her home while she was hospitalized. As indicated above, if Ms. Culberson was unable to perform her duties as treasurer, MCL 169.222 required you to assume those responsibilities.

You have not provided any evidence that you have made any attempt to clarify this contribution or amend your statements to include this contribution in your reports. Nor have you denied receiving the contribution. This contribution must be accounted for on your reports.

#### Incomplete or Inaccurate Reports

On October 28, 2008 the Department notified you that your 2008 Post-Primary campaign statement contained an error or omission. Your statement indicated that your committee had a negative balance, which indicated that your committee expended more funds than it had available. You were instructed to amend your statement to accurately reflect which receipts were used to make these expenditures. You have not filed an amended 2008 Post-Primary campaign statement.

On March 13, 2009 the Department notified you that your 2009 Annual campaign statement contained an error or omission. Your statement indicated that your committee had a negative balance, which indicated that your committee expended more funds than it had available. You were instructed to amend your statement to accurately reflect which receipts were used to make these expenditures. You were also instructed to include amend Schedule 1A to reflect the name and address and occupation and address of employer for a particular \$50.00 contribution. You have not filed an amended 2009 Annual campaign statement or amended Schedule 1A.

On October 8, 2013 the Department notified you that your 2010 Annual campaign statement contained an error or omission. The beginning balance on your 2010 Annual campaign statement did not reflect the ending balance on your 2009 Annual campaign statement. Additionally, your 2010 Annual campaign statement did not reflect the debts that had been reported on previous campaign statements. You were instructed to amend your campaign statement to reflect accurate beginning and ending balances and the debts still owed by the committee. You have not filed an amended 2010 Annual campaign statement.

Also on October 8, 2013 the Department notified you that you still had previous outstanding error and omission notices that had not been responded to. You were instructed to submit the appropriate amendments by October 21, 2013.

In your answer to Mr. Johnson's complaint, you stated that "[a]ll remaining errors or omissions per the notice of October 8, 2013 will be corrected and submitted to the State by the due date." Despite your assurances, you have failed to file amended statements and you have not corrected any of the errors or omissions.

Finally, Mr. Johnson alleged that your statements do not reflect the \$4,500.00 refund made to IAFF Local 1252 on August 11, 2009. A review of your 2010 Annual campaign statement indicates that you have not included this refund on your statement. If the refund was made with funds from the committee, it should be reflected as an expenditure.

Therefore, based on the foregoing, the Department finds that there may be reason to believe that you violated the MCFA, by late-filing reports, failing to file your 2012 Annual campaign statement, filing incomplete or inaccurate reports, and by failing to disclose a contribution. Having made this determination, the Department is required by law to attempt to resolve this

matter informally. MCL 169.215(10). The Department will send, under separate cover, a proposed conciliation agreement.

Please be advised that if the Department is unable to resolve this complaint informally, it is required by MCL 169.215(10)-(11) to refer this matter to the Attorney General with a request that his office prosecute for the crime of failing to file two or more statements for 30 days, a misdemeanor violation of MCL 169.233(8), 235(5), or commence an administrative hearing to enforce the civil penalties provided in MCL 169.233(10), (11); 169.335(6).
