Dear Ms. Glass, Mr. Honke, and Ms. Sill-Crain:

The Department of State (Department) received a formal complaint filed by Amy Lawrence against each of you, alleging that you violated section 47(1) of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.247(1), by failing to include a complete and correct identification statement on certain campaign material. A copy of the complaint is provided as an enclosure with this letter.

The MCFA and corresponding administrative rules require a person who produces printed material that relates to an election to include the phrase "Paid for by [name and address of the person who paid for the item]." MCL 169.247(1), Mich. Admin. R 169.36(2). A knowing violation constitutes a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000.00, imprisonment for up to 93 days, or both. MCL 169.247(6).

In support of her complaint, Ms. Lawrence provided a flyer which states, "Vote November 8th For Jacquelyn Sill-Crain [,] Stella Glass [,] William Shane Honke [.]" There does not appear to be a paid-for-by statement on the flyer.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. <u>It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true.</u>

If you wish to file a written response to the complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. You may each submit an answer, or you may submit one answer signed by each of you. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1st Floor, 430 West

Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

A copy of your reply will be provided to Ms. Lawrence, who will have an opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement to the Department. After reviewing all of the statements and materials provided by the parties, the Department will determine whether "there may be reason to believe that a violation of [the MCFA] has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). Note that the Department's enforcement powers include the possibility of entering a conciliation agreement, conducting an administrative hearing, or referring this matter to the Attorney General for enforcement of the criminal penalty provided in section 47(6) of the Act.

The Department of State (Department) has concluded its review of the complaint you filed against Stella Glass, William Shane Honke, and Jacquelyn Sill-Crain (Respondents), concerning an alleged violation of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 et seq. This letter concerns the disposition of your complaint.

The MCFA and corresponding administrative rules require a person who produces printed material that relates to an election to include the phrase "Paid for by [name and address of the person who paid for the item]." MCL 169.247(1), Mich. Admin. R 169.36(2).

You alleged that Respondents failed to include a complete and correct paid-for-by statement on a campaign flyer.

You filed your complaint on December 1, 2016. Ms. Glass filed an answer on January 19, 2017, and Ms. Sill-Crain filed an answer on January 26, 2017. You did not file a rebuttal statement with the Department.

In support of your complaint, you provided a flyer which stated, "Vote November 8th for Jacquelyn Sill-Crain [,] Stella Glass [, and] William Shane Honke [.]" The flyer did not appear to contain a paid-for-by statement. You stated in your complaint that you believed that all three knew who distributed the flyer.

In response to your complaint, Ms. Glass and Ms. Sill-Crain both asserted that they did not produce flyers and were unaware of who did. Absent any evidence to the contrary, the

Department takes Respondents at their word that they did not pay for the flyer in question. Therefore, your complaint is dismissed.
