Dear Mr. Conely:

The Department of State (Department) received a formal complaint filed by William Rockwell against you, alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 et seq. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 et seq. A copy of the complaint and supporting documentation is enclosed with this letter.

The MCFA requires a committee to file a statement of organization within 10 days after the committee is formed. MCL 169.224(1). Late fees may be incurred if the statement of organization is filed late. *Id.* Failure to file a statement of organization for more than 30 days is a misdemeanor offense. *Id.* By statutory definition, a committee is formed when "a person receives contributions or makes expenditures for the purpose of influencing or attempting to influence the action of voters for or against the nomination or election of a candidate . . . if contributions received total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year or expenditures made total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year." MCL 169.203(4). A statement of organization must be filed within 10 days of reaching one of these \$500.00 thresholds.

The Act further requires committees to file periodic campaign finance statements and reports. MCL 169.233. The failure to file a single campaign statement may trigger late filing fees. MCL 169.233(7). In certain circumstances, a failure to file may constitute a misdemeanor offense. MCL 169.233(8).

Mr. Rockwell alleges that you received contributions or made expenditures exceeding the \$500.00 threshold and have not filed a statement of organization or filed any required campaign finance statements.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true.

If you wish to file a written response to the complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 430 West

Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

A copy of your reply will be provided to Mr. Rockwell, who will have an opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement to the Department. After reviewing all of the statements and materials provided by the parties, the Department will determine whether "there may be reason to believe that a violation of [the MCFA] has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). Note that the Department's enforcement powers include the possibility of entering a conciliation agreement, conducting an administrative hearing, or referring this matter to the Attorney General for enforcement of the criminal penalties provided in sections 24(1) and 33(8) of the Act.





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

Dear Mr. Conely:

The Department of State (Department) has completed its investigation of the complaint filed against you by William Rockwell, which alleged you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 et seq. This letter concerns the disposition of Mr. Rockwell's complaint.

Mr. Rockwell filed his complaint on December 13, 2016, and you filed a written response on January 19, 2017. Mr. Rockwell filed a rebuttal statement on February 7, 2017.

The MCFA requires a committee to file a statement of organization within 10 days after a committee is formed. MCL 169.224(1). Late fees may be incurred if the statement of organization is filed late. *Id.* Failure to file a statement of organization for more than 30 days is a misdemeanor offense. *Id.* By statutory definition, a committee is formed when "a person receives contributions or makes expenditures for the purpose of influencing or attempting to influence the action of voters for or against the nomination or election of a candidate . . . if contributions received total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year or expenditures made total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year." MCL 169.203(4). A statement of organization must be filed within 10 days of reaching one of these \$500.00 thresholds.

The Act further requires committees to file periodic campaign finance statements and reports. MCL 169.233. The failure to file a single campaign statement may trigger late filing fees. MCL 169.233(7). In certain circumstances, a failure to file may constitute a misdemeanor offense. MCL 169.233(8).

The Act also requires "[a] person, other than a committee, who makes an independent expenditure, advocating the election of a candidate . . . in an amount of \$100.01 or more in a calendar year" to file an independent expenditure report within 10 days of the expenditure "with the clerk of the county of residence of that person." MCL 169.251. An independent expenditure is "an expenditure by a person if the expenditure is not made at the direction of, or under the control of, another person and if the expenditure is not a contribution to a committee." MCL 169.209(2).

Finally, the Act requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further violation by using informal methods [,]" if it finds that there may be reason to believe that a violation has occurred, and if the Department is unable to correct or prevent additional

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violations, it must ask the Attorney General to prosecute if a crime has been committed. MCL 169.215(10)(a). The objective of an informal resolution is "to correct the violation or prevent a further violation [.]" *Id*.

Mr. Rockwell alleged that you made expenditures exceeding the \$500.00 threshold and did not file a statement of organization or any required campaign finance statements. As evidence, Mr. Rockwell provided invoice number 54-33675 from image30 issued to the Committee to Elect Bill, Roger & James (Committee) for signs totaling \$499.26, invoice number 54-33774 from image360 issued to the Committee for signs and decals totaling \$306.81, pictures of a sign which stated, VOTE Nov 4<sup>th</sup> BILL TROMBLEY [,] ROGER L. MYERS [, and] JAMES A. ALEXANDER JR." which indicated that it was paid for by the Committee, and a copy of a postcard which stated, "VOTE Nov 8<sup>th</sup> BILL TROMBLEY [,] ROGER L. MYERS [, and] JAMES A. ALEXANDER JR."

In your response, you asserted that you "did not form a committee because there was no reason to." You provided a letter from Aaron Posuniak on image360 letterhead which states that invoice number 54-33774 was billed incorrectly to the Committee. The letter further explains that the invoice was subsequently billed to and paid for by the Bill Trombley/Kids First committee. You also provided a corrected copy of the invoice along with a proof copy of the campaign material covered by that invoice stating it was paid for by Bill Trombley/Kids First. Finally, you provided the entire original postcard submitted in part by Mr. Rockwell with his complaint. The postcard states that it was paid for by the Committee to Elect Bill Trombley/Kids First, the Committee to Elect Roger Myers for Brighton School Board, and the Election Committee for James Allen Alexander Jr."

The MCFA defines a committee as "a person who receives contributions or makes expenditures for the purpose of influencing or attempting to influence the action of the voters for or against the nomination or election of a candidate . . . if contributions received total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year or expenditures made total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year."

While you admit that you made expenditures for campaign materials urging readers to vote for Bill Trombley, Roger Meyers, and James Alexander, Jr. for Brighton School Board, the evidence does not support a reason to believe those expenditures totaled \$500.00 or more in calendar year. The evidence originally submitted to the Department included invoices totaling \$806.07 and a copy of a postcard. However, you provided a letter and corrected invoice from the vendor stating that \$306.81 was incorrectly billed to the Committee and you provided the original postcard which indicated it was not paid for by the Committee. Based on the evidence provided, your expenditures appear to have totaled \$499.26. This amount fell below the threshold which would have required you to register a committee and file committee statements and reports.

The Department does note, however, that you were required to file an independent expenditure report because you made an independent expenditure of \$100.01 or more to advocate for the election of Mr. Trombley, Mr. Meyers, and Mr. Alexander. You filed this independent expenditure report with the Livingston County Clerk's office when this matter was brought to your attention. The Department has confirmed with the Livingston County Clerk that an independent expenditure report was filed on March 22, 2017 disclosing your expenditure to image 360 in the amount of \$499.26.

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Because you quickly took corrective measures once your failure to file an independent expenditure report was brought to your attention and the Department is satisfied that proper disclosure has now been made, in accordance with the Department's authority to informally resolve complaints through corrective action, MCL 169.215(10), the Department now issues this warning letter.

The Department is advising you that section 51 requires you to timely file a complete and accurate independent expenditure report if you expend \$100.01 or more in a calendar year to advocate for the election or defeat of a candidate. Please be advised that this notice has served to remind you of your obligation under the Act to file an independent expenditure report, and may be used in future proceedings as evidence that tends to establish a knowing violation of the Act.

The Department now considers the complaint resolved and this matter closed.
