Please be advised that due to the disqualification by the Wayne County Clerk of the only remaining candidate for the office of **Judge of the Wayne County Probate Court, Regular Term Non-Incumbent position**, candidates interested in seeking this position have until **Friday, June 3 at 4:00 p.m.** to qualify for placement on the November 8, 2022 ballot. See MCL 168.435(2). Interested candidates must file all of the following materials with the Wayne County Clerk's Office:

- Nonpartisan nominating petitions containing a minimum of 1,000 valid signatures.
- The [Affidavit of Identity and Receipt of Filing](#) (2 copies).
- The [Affidavit of Constitutional Qualification](#) (1 copy).

All filing materials must be received by the Wayne County Clerk's Office by 4:00 p.m. on June 3 to be considered timely. Please contact the Wayne County Clerk's office for any questions on filing.
