Agenda item: Consideration of meeting minutes for approval (July 21, 2022).

Board action on agenda item: The Board approved the minutes of the July 21, 2022 meeting as submitted. Moved by Bradshaw; supported by Houskamp. Ayes: Bradshaw, Gurewitz, Houskamp. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Agenda item: Canvass and certification of the August 2, 2022 primary election.

Board action on agenda item: The Board approved the motion “Based on an examination of the returns received by the Secretary of State for the August 2, 2022 primary election, we, the undersigned members of the Board of State Canvassers, certify that the following report is a true statement of the votes cast at the primary for the offices certified by this Board. We further certify that the persons named in the following “List of Nominees” are duly nominated for the offices indicated and are qualified to appear as candidates for such offices on the November 8, 2022 general election ballot.” Moved by Bradshaw; supported by Houskamp. Ayes: Bradshaw, Gurewitz, Houskamp. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Agenda item: Consideration of the sufficiency of the qualifying petitions submitted by Barry Altman for the office of State Senator, 3rd District.

Board action on agenda item: The Board moved to accept the staff recommendation and determine the qualifying petition submitted by Barry Altman insufficient. Moved by Houskamp; supported by Bradshaw. Ayes: Bradshaw, Gurewitz, Houskamp. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Agenda item: Assignment of the number designation for the constitutional amendment proposed by the Michigan Legislature, House Joint Resolution R.

Board action on agenda item: The Board moved to designate the constitutional amendment submitted by the Legislature as Proposal 22-1 on the November 8, 2022 general election ballot. Moved by Bradshaw;

supported by Houskamp. Ayes: Bradshaw, Gurewitz, Houskamp. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Agenda item: Consideration of the 100-word statement of purpose for House Joint Resolution R.

A proposal to amend the state constitution to require annual public financial disclosure reports by legislators and other state officers and change state legislator term limit to 12 total years in legislature

This proposed constitutional amendment would:

- Require members of legislature, governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, and attorney general file annual public financial disclosure reports after 2023, including assets, liabilities, income sources, future employment agreements, gifts, travel reimbursements, and positions held in organizations except religious, social, and political organizations.
- Require legislature implement but not limit or restrict reporting requirements.
- Replace current term limits for state representatives and state senators with a 12-year total limit in any combination between house and senate, except a person elected to senate in 2022 may be elected the number of times allowed when that person became a candidate.
