Facebook ads placed on 7/4/20, 7/16/20, and 8/4/20 "tangibly benefit the nomination or election of a candidate" in promoting candidates for Ann Arbor City Council: Lisa Disch, Linh Song, Travis Radina, Jen Eyer, and Erica Briggs. (See Facebook Ad Library link below.) Campaign finance reports filed starting with (and since) 12/5/18 have reported zero expenditures. There was a failure to report \$1796.97 in expenditures on Facebook ads in 2020, as well as expenditures (unknown) to maintain a political website.

These statements report a total of \$1024.03 in Facebook ad expenditures. Eight subsequent statements (10/25/18, 12/05/18, 7/25/19, 10/25/19, 1/30/20, 7/22/20, 10/20/20, 1/11/21) report zero Facebook ad expenditures for "Christopher Taylor for Mayor."

Over the same period of time (5/7/18 - 3/17/21) Facebook Ad library identifies a total of \$2821 in expenditures by "Christopher Taylor for Mayor." Note unreported Facebook ads placed on 8/1/18, 8/5/18, 8/7/18, 11/5/18 (2), 11/6/18, 11/7/18, 5/30/20, 6/7/20, 6/13/20, **7/4/20**, **7/16/20**, **8/4/20**, and 8/18/20 (dates in bold indicate ads promoting the election of candidates).

The Department of State (Department) received a formal complaint filed by Eric Sturgis against you alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 *et seq.* A copy of the complaint and supporting documentation is enclosed with this letter.

The MCFA requires candidates and committees file contributions and expenditures with the appropriate filing official by specific dates. MCL 169.233(1) – (3). The MCFA requires a committee that receives or expends more than \$1,000 during any election to file campaign finance reports in compliance with the Act. MCL 169.233(6). A person who knowingly omits or underreports expenditures required to be disclosed by the Act is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$1,000 or the amount of the expenditures omitted or underreported, whichever is greater. MCL 169.233(11).

Mr. Sturgis alleges that you have failed to report Facebook advertisements from 2018-2021.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 *et seq.* An explanation of the process is included in the enclosed guidebook.

If you wish to file a written response to this complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1st Floor, 430 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

The Department of State (Department) received a formal complaint filed by Eric Sturgis against you alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 *et seq.* A copy of the complaint and supporting documentation is enclosed with this letter.¹

The MCFA requires candidates and committees file contributions and expenditures with the appropriate filing official by specific dates. MCL 169.233(1) – (3). The MCFA requires a committee that receives or expends more than \$1,000 during any election to file campaign finance reports in compliance with the Act. MCL 169.233(6). A person who knowingly omits or underreports expenditures required to be disclosed by the Act is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$1,000 or the amount of the expenditures omitted or underreported, whichever is greater. MCL 169.233(11).

Mr. Sturgis alleges that you have failed to report Facebook advertisements from 2018-2021.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 *et seq.* An explanation of the process is included in the enclosed guidebook.

¹ Mr. Sturgis supplied the Department with a mailing address on Nature Cove Ct. for your committee, and the Department sent a Notice of this complaint to that address on May 24, 2021. Your campaign statements on file with the Washtenaw County Clerk, however, suggest that you may no longer use that address. As a courtesy, the Department is re-sending this Notice to the new address supplied on your most recent campaign statement.

If you wish to file a written response to this complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1st Floor, 430 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

Dear Mr. Fracassi:

This letter responds to your letter of April 12, 2022 regarding a formal complaint alleging a violation of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act concerning underreported Facebook advertising expenses between 8/1/18 and 8/18/20. I am responding on behalf of *Christopher Taylor for Mayor*.

The complaint cites Facebook ads placed between August 1, 2018 and August 18, 2020 that were not reported in subsequent campaign statements. In checking his credit card records, Mayor Taylor now realizes that the candidate committee inadvertently failed to report payments to Facebook from his personal credit card. The attached record shows \$1,547.46 in Facebook charges that should have been reported as in-kind contributions. I have filed amended statements to indicate these in-kind contributions (attached). I also note that, as alleged in the complaint, these Facebook ads were clearly identified as sponsored by *Christopher Taylor for Mayor* so there was nothing misleading about their origin. Moreover, a candidate's own contributions are unlimited.

The complaint also alleges a failure to report the cost of maintaining a website for www.taylorforannabor.com. The attached July 2017 Quarterly Report shows a payment of \$395.64 to "Bluehost.com." This was payment for a 36-month website maintenance contract, through March 2020. Mayor Taylor did renew that contract in February 2020 from his personal credit card but due to a transition of campaign treasurers this was inadvertently not reported. I

have reported it as an in-kind contribution to the campaign in the attached amended statement.

This letter concerns the campaign finance complaint filed against you by Eric Sturgis, which alleged certain violations of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 *et seq.*

In his complaint, Mr. Sturgis alleged that you failed to report certain expenditures made to the committee and underreported other transactions. By letter dated April 26, 2022, your treasurer, Joan Lowenstein, responded to the complaint indicating that it appeared that certain advertisements were inadvertently made via the candidate's personal credit card and not reported over as in-kind contributions. With your response, you provided copies of credit card receipts and the amended reports filed with the Washtenaw County Clerk's Office.

By letter dated June 13, 2022, the Department notified Mr. Sturgis of his right to file a rebuttal. To date, none has been received.

The Department has reviewed the complaint and your response and concludes that there is sufficient evidence to support the conclusion that a potential violation of the Act has occurred. As you have indicated, expenditures were erroneously purchased through a personal credit card and not properly reported, but since have been amended. Upon reaching this conclusion, the Department is obligated to attempt to informally resolve the complaint. MCL 169.215(10).

Given that you provided evidence, rationale and immediately disclosed the transactions upon becoming aware of their omission, the Department determines that a formal warning is a sufficient resolution to this complaint. The Department now considers this matter closed and will take no further action against you at this time.

The Department notes that your committee may be assessed a late-filing fee by the Washtenaw County Clerk for any statement that was not timely filed. MCL 169.233(7). Late-filing fees are assessed and collected by the filing official with whom the statements are filed. MCL 169.217(1). Any questions regarding these late-filing fees should be directed to the Washtenaw County Clerk.

Please be advised that this notice has served to remind you of your obligation under the Act to disclose contributions and expenditures and may be used in future proceedings as evidence that tends to establish a knowing violation of the Act.
