





What do you believe are the 3 biggest issues/challenges before the City Commission and how would you address them?

#### Mike O'Connor:

Financial, financial and financial. The City owes the Retirement Fund \$6 Million [see comments next section]. Use 100% of the state gas tax funds, \$800,000 per year in the Department of Public Works for materials, Labor would be paid from property toxes. The City must learn to live on the tax funds and state funds being provided. The city has just undertaken to build a new Wastewater Plant at a cost of \$21 Million or \$30 per household per month for the next 30 years. The cost to citizens to live in Gladstone needs to be controlled. Retirees with a fixed income can not afford a special road assessment or skyrocketing utility costs. The commission needs to look at the needs of citizens before the needs of the city staff. Working with other cities and the county to provide more services at less cost.

Every community has budget challenges. How would you address issues effecting the City budget?

#### Mike O'Connor:

The City spends more than it takes in. The result has been to rob the electric, water, wastewater, and trosh funds to support an angoing structure deficit. The Retirement Fund is underfunded by \$6-\$9 Million (based on annual returns) and has to be paid off by 2027. The payment to Retirement Fund is \$1.3 Million in 2022, 2023. 2024, 2025 (based on a &,35% market return and could be as high as \$1.6 Million in based on 5.35% market return). The total city property tax is \$1.6 Million per year. It takes all a four property tax to cover the mandatory payments. A bond issue now for \$6 Million would pay off the Retirement Fund Debt and could be paid at a rate of \$300,000 per year over 30 Years. The City must not use utility funds to pay for services provided by property tax. The city has also transferred funds for roads to the General Fund with the results beling terrible roads in Gladstone and Over \$1 Million is special road assessments being added to citizens tax bill.

Economic Development encompasses many areas including the Gladstone North Shore. How can the Commission address these issues?

#### Mike O'Connor

The North Share is not property owned by the city, it is owned by Bessa and the Coal Company and only a few acres are owned by the city with a large section being used to house a concrete pile. The City should not devote city resources both time and now over \$100,000 to find a developer. If their is a need, the developer will come to the property owners with an offer and the city can then assist. The current businesses in the city and

#### Mike O'Connor:

The Commission does not need to address housing issues. The private sector can and does provide housing. Gladstone has a variety of available homes and rental properties.

There are 9 candidates running to fill 3 seats. What makes you the best candidate for the City Commission?

#### Mike O'Connor:



The Department of State (Department) has received a formal complaint alleging you have violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA). Specifically, the complaint alleges that you, or organizations under your control, paid for newspaper advertisements in the October 10, 2021 edition of the *U.P. Action News* without properly reporting the advertisements as contributions or expenditures as required by the MCFA. A copy of the complaint is enclosed.

#### Advertisements 1 and 2

The MCFA requires all expenditures made by a candidate in support of their candidacy be reported to the relevant filing official as an expenditure made by the candidate's committee. An expenditure is "a payment, donation, loan, or promise of payment of money or anything of ascertainable monetary value for goods, materials, services, or facilities in assistance of, or in opposition to, the nomination or election of a candidate." MCL 169.206(1). The purchase of a communication which advocates for "the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate" in "express terms" is an expenditure for the purposes of the MCFA. MCL 169.206(2)(j). Express advocacy, in turn, can take two forms: explicitly statements advocating for a candidate's election or defeat, *Buckley v. Valeo*, 424 US 1, 44 n. 52 (1976), or non-explicit statements which nevertheless are "susceptible of no reasonable interpretation other than as an appeal to vote for or against a specific candidate." *FEC v. Wisconsin Right to Life, Inc.*, 551 US 449, 470 (2007).

Two of the advertisements you purchased may have violated the above statutory scheme. The advertisement titled "Mike O'Conner a/k/a Citizen Mike" (Advertisement 1) indicates that it was

paid for by "Mike O'Conner." The advertisement appearing directly below Advertisement 1, titled "Mike O'Conner for Gladstone City Commissioner" (Advertisement 2) indicates that it was paid for by "the Committee to elect Mike O'Conner." Based on these paid for by statements, it appears that Advertisement 1 was paid for out of your personal funds, while Advertisement 2 was paid for out of committee funds. Advertisement 1 does not explicitly advocate for your election to the Gladstone City Commission, but Advertisement 2 explicitly supports your candidacy. This complaint concerns whether the content of Advertisement 1, combined with its placement directly above Advertisement 2, makes Advertisement 1 a statement which is "susceptible of no reasonable interpretation other than as an appeal to vote for or against a specific candidate" and thus an expenditure under the MCFA which was required to be made from your committee account rather than from personal funds.

#### Advertisement 3

In Michigan, all money spent "in assistance of, or in opposition to, the nomination or election of a candidate" is either an expenditure or a contribution. Any entity making more than \$500 of expenditures or contributions, other than independent expenditures, <sup>2</sup> must register as a committee, MCL 169.203(4), by filing a statement of organization. MCL 169.224(1). A failure to file a statement of organization within 30 days of the date the statement becomes required is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000. MCL 169.224. Additionally, committees must report all contributions and expenditures on regular campaign statements. MCL 169.226. A failure to file required campaign finance statements is punishable with late filing fees, and a failure to file two or more statements is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine up not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both. MCL 169.233(8).

The advertisement titled "VOTE for CHANGE in Gladstone" (Advertisement 3) may be a contribution of more than \$500 from the Gladstone Citizens Council to the Committee to Elect Mike O'Conner. Advertisement 3 explicitly advocates readers "vote for change" and lists Mr. O'Conner as one of the candidates challenging the incumbent officeholders. If Advertisement 3 is a contribution of more than \$500, Gladstone Citizens Council would be required to register as a committee and report any contributions or expenditures made which are regulated by the MCFA.

#### Responding to This Complaint and Subsequent Process

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. <u>It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as</u>

<u>true</u>. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 *et seq*. An explanation of the process is included in the enclosed guidebook.

If you wish to file a written response to this complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. All materials must be sent to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 430 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

A copy of your answer will be provided to Ms. Nelson, who will have an opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement to the Department. After reviewing all of the statements and materials provided by the parties, the Department will determine whether "there may be reason to believe that a violation of [the MCFA] has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). Note that the Department's enforcement powers include the possibility of entering a conciliation agreement, conducting an administrative hearing, or referring this matter to the Attorney General for enforcement of the penalty provided in section 33(11) of the Act.

The Department of State (Department) has finished investigating the campaign finance complaint filed against you by Stacy Nelson on November 4, 2021. The complaint alleges that you, or organizations under your control, paid for three newspaper advertisements in the October 10, 2021 edition of the U.P. Action News without properly reporting the advertisements as contributions or expenditures as required by the MCFA, and that you have failed to place a proper paid for by statement on certain campaign related materials.

You responded to the complaint on May 3, 2022. In your response you indicated that the "Citizen Mike" advertisement was not intended to be a campaign advertisement Additionally, you indicated that Gladstone Citizens Council is a nonprofit organization with a mission to provide information to the residents of Gladstone. Finally, you stated the Vote for Change advertisement was intended as a notification to the public and an opportunity to provide access to the citizens of Gladstone.

Ms. Nelson was notified of your response on July 14, 2022 but did not provide a rebuttal.

The MCFA requires all expenditures made by a candidate in support of their candidacy be reported to the relevant filing official as expenditures made by the candidate's committee. An expenditure is "a payment, donation, loan, or promise of payment of money or anything of ascertainable monetary value for goods, materials, services, or facilities in assistance of, or in opposition to, the nomination or election of a candidate." MCL 169.206(1). The purchase of a communication which advocates for "the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate" in

"express terms" is an expenditure for the purposes of the MCFA. MCL 169.206(2)(j). Express advocacy, in turn, can take two forms: explicitly statements advocating for a candidate's election or defeat, *Buckley v. Valeo*, 424 US 1, 44 n. 52 (1976), or non-explicit statements which nevertheless are "susceptible of no reasonable interpretation other than as an appeal to vote for or against a specific candidate." *FEC v. Wisconsin Right to Life, Inc.*, 551 US 449, 470 (2007).

Additionally, all money spent "in assistance of, or in opposition to, the nomination or election of a candidate" is either an expenditure or a contribution. Any entity spending or receiving more than \$500 in expenditures or contributions, other than independent expenditures, must register as a committee, MCL 169.203(4), by filing a statement of organization. MCL 169.224(1). A failure to file a statement of organization within 30 days of the date the statement becomes required is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000. MCL 169.224. Additionally, committees must report all contributions and expenditures on regular campaign statements. MCL 169.226. A failure to file required campaign finance statements is punishable with late filing fees, and a failure to file two or more statements is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both. MCL 169.233(8).

There are three advertisements at issue. The first advertisement is titled "Mike O'Connor a/k/a Citizen Mike" (Advertisement 1), was printed on October 10, 2021, and indicates that it was paid for by "Mike O'Connor." This advertisement discusses lawsuits that you brought against the City of Gladstone and budget matters within the City. In your response, you indicated that this advertisement was not intended to be a campaign advertisement but a rebuttal to a statement made previously by a city commissioner.

From the outset, the Department must consider whether this advertisement constitutes express advocacy. Although Advertisement 1 does not explicitly advocate for your election to the Gladstone City Commission, its placement in conjunction with Advertisement 2, discussion of issues relevant to the election, and the fact that you placed a paid for by statement on the advertisement, is enough to conclude that it was published with the intention of expressly advocating for your election.

Because this article was designed to expressly advocate for your election, it is covered by the Act's requirements, meaning that the advertisement should have been purchased using committee funds or reported in the 2021 pre-general election campaign statement. However, since this advertisement was not reported, there may be reason to believe a violation of the Act has occurred.

The second advertisement is titled "Mike O'Connor for Gladstone City Commissioner" and clearly contains words of express advocacy. This advertisement was paid for by your committee, but fails to contain a proper paid for by statement because it entirely omits the address in violation of section 47. MCL 169.247. Accordingly, the Department concludes there may be reason to believe that a potential violation has occurred.

The third advertisement is titled "VOTE for CHANGE in Gladstone" and was paid for by the Gladstone Citizens Council. This advertisement tells voters "There are 6 challengers vying for the 3 City Commissioner Seats to oust the existing Commissioners in Gladstone." This clearly

constitutes words of express advocacy since it urges voters to vote against the incumbent commissioners. Because advertisement 3 expressly advocates for the election of several candidates, Gladstone Citizens Council may have been required to either file an independent expenditure report under section 51 or to form and register an independent committee. However, since neither occurred, the Department concludes there may be reason to believe that a potential violation of the Act has occurred.

#### Resolution

Upon review, the evidence submitted supports the conclusion that a potential violation of the Act has occurred. When the Department finds that there may be reason to believe a violation has occurred, the Act requires the Department to use "informal methods such as a conference [or] conciliation" to correct the potential violation or to prevent further violation. MCL 169.215(10). The Department has 90 business days to reach an informal resolution of the matter. *Id*.

Given this, please contact the undersigned by emailing <u>BOERegulatory@Michigan.gov</u> to informally resolve this complaint. If the Department is unable to informally resolve the complaint by February 16, 2023, the Act requires the Department to refer the matter to the Department of Attorney General with a request that her office prosecute the criminal penalties outlined under the Act. MCL 169.233(11).

I have reviewed your letter and your initial determination there are 3 issues concerning advertisements in the local free shopping paper associated with the election.

Issue 1- Not a full address associated with campaign ad only had the following " Mike O'Connor Paid by the Committee to elect Mike O'Connor." Indeed I was not aware of the mandatory requirement for an address.

Issue 2- In the same issue I replied to a personal attack by a Gladstone City Commissioner at a city commission meeting. I noted, "Paid for by Mike O'Connor." This was a personal attack on my character and required a reply. The placement of the two ads, one campaign and one personal, was totally up to the local paper.

Issue 3- Gladstone Citizen Council printed an ad to advise the citizens there were people running for the city commission. The city had not provided any information to the general public the deadline to file or the people which were running. Subsequent ads listed all names of those running for the open seats and encouraged everyone to vote.

The election was for 3 seats being non-partisan in a relatively small town of 5000 on the city commission. Not being a full time politician, only trying to help and make the city better, I'm sure the exact letter of the law was not followed. There was no intent to deceive the public, hide funds or provide any undue influence to the voters.

I would look at this as an opportunity at the local level to provide appropriate information for all those seeking to run, provide guidance on filing with the county clerk, tracking all fund raising, donations and expenses. In addition to requirements to provide full name and address information on all printed materials.
