- MCL 169.224 failure to file a statement of organization
- MCL 169.234 failure to file statements
- MCL 169.226(1) failure to report contributions and/or expenditures

# Explain how those sections were violated:

- 1. A renewal of the Macomb County Public Transportation Millage appeared on the Nov. 8, 2022, ballot.
- 2. I received two mailings urging me in terms of express advocacy to vote "yes" on the millage.
- 3. On both mailings, in the return address area was stated "Paid for regulated funds by Moving Macomb Forward", with a return address of 12856 Belle River Rd., Memphis, MI 48041.
  - a. On both mailings, the return address area also bears the logo of Allied Union Services, a printing and mailing company located in Fenton, Michigan.<sup>1</sup>
  - b. Both mailings were sent using the PRESRT STD postage class. One of them stated "Fenton, MI PERMIT NO. 1776".
- 4. A website mentioned on the mail pieces, located at https://renewmacombtransit.com, also carries an identifier showing the same committee name and address.

- 5. The return address included in the identifiers appears to be physically located in St. Clair County.
- 6. Because the committee address is located in St. Clair County and the ballot question appeared on the ballot in Macomb County, I inquired with both counties (as well as the State of Michigan) as to the status of this committee.
  - a. The Macomb County Clerk's campaign finance filings show that there was, at one time, a ballot question committee registered in Macomb County called "MOVING MACOMB FORWARD COMMITTEE" (135596). However, that committee was dissolved effective December 31, 2011, according to the Macomb County Clerk's office.<sup>2</sup> At the time of the dissolution of MOVING MACOMB FORWARD COMMITTEE, the Macomb County Clerk informed the committee treasurer that should they wish to participate in future elections, they need to file a new statement of organization.<sup>3</sup> On the county's website, this committee is the only committee listed whose name contains "Moving Macomb Forward". To date, that committee remains in a dissolved state.
  - b. St. Clair County Elections Director Debbie Rhein informed me via email on November 1, 2022, that there is no ballot question committee registered in St. Clair County with the name "Moving Macomb Forward".
  - c. On the Michigan Secretary of State campaign finance website, no committee could be located whose name contains the phrase "Moving Macomb Forward".
- 7. It's unclear if the Moving Macomb Forward organization mentioned on the mailers is a continuation of the dissolved committee in Macomb County or whether they are two distinct committees with nearly identical names. Regardless, the 2022 campaign activity supporting the transit millage renewal occurred without having a filed statement of organization (or, at least not in St. Clair County or Macomb County).
- 8. In addition, the committee likely failed to file campaign statements as well as failed to report all of its contributions and expenditures, which may include graphic design, printing, and postage for two mass mailings and domain name registration, hosting, and development services for its website.
- 9. I hereby respectfully request that the Bureau of Elections investigate whether Moving Macomb Forward violated the following sections of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act:
  - a. MCL 169.224 failing to file a statement of organization
  - b. MCL 169.234 failing to file campaign statements
  - c. MCL 169,226(1) failing to report contributions and expenditures



Dear Moving Macomb Forward:

The Department of State (Department) has received a formal complaint filed against you by Matthew Schonert alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act). Specifically, the complaint alleges that you either sent elections materials out from a dissolved committee or that you failed to form a committee. Regardless of the circumstances, the complaint alleges that you then failed to file the required campaign finance reports required of a committee. A copy of the complaint is included with this notice.

Section 24 requires committees to file a statement of organization with the proper filing official within 10 days after the committee is formed. MCL 169.224(1). Section 24 details specific requirements for all statements of organization that must be filed. See MCL 169.224(2)-(3). A person who fails to file a timely statement is subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000. MCL 169.221(13). A person who fails to file a statement of organization shall pay a late filing fee of \$10.00 per business day the report is not filed, not to exceed \$300. MCL 169.224(1). A person failing to file a statement of organization after 30 days is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000. *Id*.

By statutory definition, a committee is formed when "a person receives contributions or makes expenditures for the purpose of influencing or attempting to influence the action of the voters for or against [candidate, ballot question, etc.] if contributions received total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year or expenditures made total \$500.00 or more in a calendar year." MCL 169.203(4). For purposes of determining whether a committee exists, the word "person" includes "a group of persons acting jointly." 169.211(2).

The MCFA requires that candidates and committees record the full name, street address, amount contributed, and date of contribution for each individual from whom contributions are received. MCL 169.226(1)(e). Further, if the individual's cumulative contributions are more than \$100.00, the candidate or committee must also report the individual's occupation, employer, and principal place of business. Id. For each person other than an individual, candidates and committees need not include the additional employment information but must provide all other contributor information previously listed. MCL 169.226(1)(g).

The MCFA requires ballot question committees to file contributions and expenditures with the appropriate filing official by specific dates. MCL 169.234(1) – (3). A treasurer who knowingly omits or underreports expenditures required to be disclosed by the Act is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$1,000 or the amount of the expenditures omitted or underreported, whichever is greater. MCL 169.234(7).

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Department's examination of these matters and your right to respond to the allegations before the Department proceeds further. <u>It is important to understand that the Department is neither making this complaint nor accepting the allegations as true</u>. The investigation and resolution of this complaint is governed by section 15 of the Act and the corresponding administrative rules, R 169.51 *et seq*. An explanation of the process is included in the enclosed guidebook.

If you wish to file a written response to this complaint, you are required to do so within 15 business days of the date of this letter. Your response may include any written statement or additional documentary evidence you wish to submit. Materials may be emailed to BOERegulatory@michigan.gov or mailed to the Department of State, Bureau of Elections, Richard H. Austin Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 430 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48918. If you fail to submit a response, the Department will render a decision based on the evidence furnished by the complainant.

A copy of your answer will be provided to Mr. Schonert, who will have an opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement to the Department. After reviewing the statements and materials provided by the parties, the Department will determine whether "there may be reason to believe that a violation of [the MCFA] has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). Note that the Department's enforcement powers include the possibility of entering a conciliation agreement, conducting an administrative hearing, or referring this matter to the Attorney General for enforcement.

### Dear Bureau of Elections:

Our firm represents the ballot question committee that is currently named Macomb Moving Forward, but that was originally named Moving Macomb Forward before its name was amended ("MMF"). This is in response to the Bureau of Elections' letter dated February 6, 2023 regarding a complaint filed against Moving Macomb Forward by Matthew Schonert ("Complainant") alleging certain violations of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (the "Act"), 1976 PA 388, as amended, MCL 169.201 *et seq*, including alleged violations of MCL 169.244 for failing to file a statement of organization, MCL 169.234 for failing to file a campaign statements, and MCL 169.226(1) for failing to report expenditures and contributions.

We note that this complaint and the Bureau's letter use the MMF address (as opposed to the address of a prior committee that used the Moving Macomb Forward name and was dissolved in 2011). Therefore, to the extent that this complaint is deemed to be directed at MMF, for these alleged violations, MMF states a violation of the Act has not occurred.

However, MMF does admit that the interchange of the two names "Moving" and "Macomb" is confusing, and to try and avoid that confusion with the prior committee, MMF originally registered with one name and almost immediately changed to the other. MMF also acknowledges that its "paid for by" statement on the two mailings identified by Mr. Schonert would have been better if it used the amended name "Macomb Moving Forward" as opposed to the original committee name of "Moving Macomb Forward."

MMF (using its original and amended name) does assert, however, that it is a properly registered ballot question committee and has timely filed its contribution and expenditure reports. Its

Statement of Organization was filed with the Macomb County Clerk on October 11, 2022, and originally named the committee "Moving Macomb Forward." (Exhibit 1). MMF then filed an amended Statement of Organization and changed the name to "Macomb Moving Forward." (Exhibit 2). MMF has filed its contribution and expenditure reports with the Macomb County Clerk under the amended name, "Macomb Moving Forward." (Exhibit 3).<sup>1</sup>

MMF decided to amend the committee name to "Macomb Moving Forward" in an effort to avoid confusion because, as Mr. Schonert pointed out, "Moving Macomb Forward" resembles the name of a dissolved committee "Moving Macomb Forward Committee." The name change has unfortunately and apparently caused more confusion to MMF's vendor, the Macomb County Clerk, the Macomb County website—which MMF would have hoped identified its reports and filings under both the original and amended names—and unfortunately Mr. Schonert as a recipient of the MMF mailings. Notably, typing "Macomb," "Moving," or "Forward" individually into to the Macomb County website's "Committee Name" search function generates all of the registration and all the reports for MMF.

Admittedly, the mailers attached to the complaint reference the original committee name and state "Paid for with regulated funds by Moving Macomb Forward." The mailers were paid for by MMF, and its pre-election expenditure report identifies the funds paid to MMF's vendor, Byrum & Fisk Communications, to print and copy these mailers. (Exhibit 4). The printed "paid for by" statement interchanging "Macomb" and "Moving" on the mailers was an unintentional printing mistake, one that is relatively easy to make. In fact, we note with no disrespect, that in the Bureau's February 6, 2023 letter, MMF is referred to as "Moving Macomb Forward" on page 1 and "Macomb Moving Forward" in the header on page 2. Nonetheless, we sincerely regret the inadvertent interchange of the two names.

Other than the misprint/interchange of the name on the two mailers, the address of MMF is correctly identified and matches the information MMF has submitted to the Macomb County Clerk. MMF was unaware of the printing confusion when the mailers were circulated and thus the purported violation was certainly not knowing nor intentional. MMF has asked, and we have confirmed that, corrective language on the website disclaimer was updated to remedy the confusion:<sup>2</sup>







Dear Mr. Wilk:

The Department of State (Department) has finished investigating the campaign finance complaint filed against your clients by Matthew Schonert alleging that they violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act). This letter concerns the disposition of that complaint.

Specifically, the complaint alleges that your clients either sent election materials out from a dissolved committee or that they failed to form a committee. Regardless of the circumstances, the complaint alleges that they then failed to file the campaign finance reports required of a committee.

You responded to the complaint in a letter dated March 14, 2023. In your response, you claimed that your firm represents the ballot question committee currently named Macomb Moving Forward, but that was originally named Moving Macomb Forward (MMF). You acknowledged that the name revision could be confusing, and that "its 'paid for by' statement on the two mailings identified by Mr. Schonert would have been better if it had used the amended name 'Macomb Moving Forward' as opposed to the original committee name of 'Moving Macomb Forward.""

Nonetheless, you argue that MMF is a properly registered ballot question committee and has timely filed its contribution and expenditure reports. You further indicate that MMF filed its original Statement of Organization with the Macomb County Clerk on October 11, 2022, and its amended Statement of Organization, in which it amended its name, on October 12, 2022.

While you acknowledged that the mailers use the Moving Macomb Forward rather than the Macomb Moving Forward name in its "paid for by" statement, you argued that it was an "unintentional printing mistake", that the mailers were paid for by MMF, and that MMF's pre-election report shows the payments for those mailers.

In a letter dated March 20, 2023, Mr. Schonert was provided the opportunity to submit a rebuttal statement. To date, no rebuttal has been received.

The Department has reviewed the evidence submitted in this matter and finds that insufficient evidence has been presented to support a finding of a potential violation of the MCFA. While MMF indicated in its "paid for by" statement that its name was Moving Macomb Forward rather than Macomb Moving Forward, the Department accepts that this was a printing error, that MMF formed a committee as required, and that MMF appears to have filed all required reports.

Because the violation of the MCFA alleged in the complaint has not been substantiated by sufficient evidence, the Department dismisses the complaint and will take no further enforcement action.
