Background

- 1. Devonte Sherard was a candidate for Mayor of Ecorse in 2022.1
- On February 23, 2022, Sherard filed with the Wayne County Clerk a statement of organization for a candidate committee called DeVonte Sherard for Ecorse (ID: 82-157856).
- 3. Sherard is named as the respondent in this complaint because the candidate committee is under the control and direction of the candidate.²
- 4. In a letter dated February 24, 2022, the Wayne County Clerk notified the committee that the committee did not request a reporting waiver and therefore was required to file all campaign statements.

Explanation of violation of MCL 169.226(1)(d)

- 5. On Facebook, DeVonte Sherard advertised a fundraiser to be held on June 26, 2022, at Hurryback Bar in Ecorse. (URLs and screenshots are provided in the evidence section.)
- 6. The fundraiser date falls within the reporting period for the committee's pre-primary campaign statement ("CS").
- 7. On both the date of the fundraiser and on the date that its pre-primary CS was due, the committee did not have a reporting waiver.
- 8. The committee's pre-primary CS fundraiser schedule (1F) did not list the June 26, 2022, fundraiser. The fundraiser schedule was empty.
- 9. MCL 169.226(1)(d) requires that a campaign statement include the following information for each fund-raising event held:
 - The type of event, date held, address and name, if any, of the place where the
 activity was held, and approximate number of individuals participating or in
 attendance.
 - ii. The total amount of all contributions.
 - iii. The gross receipts of the fund-raising event.
 - iv. The expenditures incident to the event.
- 10. The committee's failure to report the fundraiser information on Schedule IF constitutes a violation of MCL 169.226(1)(d).





Dear Mr. Sherard:

The Department of State (Department) has finished investigating the campaign finance complaint filed against you by Matthew Schonert alleging that you violated the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act). This letter concerns the disposition of that complaint.

The complaint alleged that you failed to report information regarding a fundraiser your committee, DeVonte Sherard for Ecorse, held on June 26, 2022.

You responded to the complaint in emails sent February 15 and 21, 2023. In your response, you claimed that you had three treasurers over the course of your campaign, which resulted in some mistakes. However, you argued that your reports had been corrected and everything was up to date.

Additionally, you submitted a letter from the Wayne County Office of the County Clerk: Election Division, which states that, as of March 7, 2023, "[y]ou have one outstanding notice of Error or Omission for your filed Pre General 2018 Campaign Statement . . . There are no other outstanding issues (campaign statements or notice of error or omissions) with this candidate committee."

Mr. Schonert provided a rebuttal statement in an email received by the Department March 15, 2023. In that statement, he argued that, while the county clerk stated that you had no outstanding issues, the clerk's office would have no way of knowing whether you had held a fundraiser and were required to submit the attendant report. Accordingly, the clerk "would be unable to advise [you] via an error/omission notice that [your] fundraiser schedule was incomplete."

The MCFA requires that candidates and committees record the full name, street address, amount contributed, and date of contribution for each individual from whom contributions are received. MCL 169.226(1)(e). Additionally, the following information regarding each fundraising event must be included in the report:

- The type of event, date held, address and name, if any, of the place where the activity was held, and approximate number of individuals participating or in attendance.
- The total amount of all contributions.
- The gross receipts of the fundraising event.
- The expenditures incident to the event.

MCL 169.226(1)(d).

The Department has reviewed the evidence submitted in this matter and your filed <u>reports</u> for the DeVonte Sherard for Ecorse committee, ID #82-157856, available on the Wayne County Campaign Finance Information System. Mr. Schonert is correct that your pre-primary statement, submitted July 14, 2022, does not include any events on the Schedule 1F fundraiser page.

The Department has reviewed the evidence submitted in this matter and finds that sufficient evidence has been presented to support a finding of a potential violation of the MCFA. While you submitted your required pre-primary statement, you did not complete the Schedule 1F to report the elements required under section 26 of the MCFA, above. Your pre-primary statement includes at least 11 contributions received on June 26, 2022, which was the date of your fundraiser. All of those contributions must be reported on the Schedule 1F fundraiser form.

This letter serves to notify you and your clients that the Department has determined there may be reason to believe that you have violated the Act and to notify you that the Department is beginning the informal resolution process.

Please submit Schedule 1F as an amendment to your pre-primary report by September 8, 2023, and notify the Department that you have done so at BOERegulatory@Michigan.gov in order to resolve this issue.

"If, after 90 business days, the secretary of state is unable to correct or prevent further violation by these informal methods, the secretary of state shall do either of the following:

- (a) Refer the matter to the attorney general for the enforcement of any criminal penalty provided by this act.
- (b) Commence a hearing as provided in subsection (11) for enforcement of any civil violation."

MCL 169.215(11).
