Dear Mr. Coll:

The Department of State (Department) has received a formal complaint alleging you have violated MCL 169.247 of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA) by failing to include a complete and correct identification statement on certain campaign-related materials. A copy of the complaint is enclosed.

The complaint was submitted to the Department on October 7, 2019 and alleges that you have distributed yard signs that did not include a proper paid for by statement. A picture of the yard signs is included with the complaint.

The MCFA and corresponding administrative rules require a person who produces printed material that relates to an election include the phrase "Paid for by [name and address of the person who paid for the item]." MCL 169.247(1), R 169.36(2). A knowing violation constitutes a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000.00, imprisonment for up to 93 days, or both. MCL 169.247(6).

Upon review, the evidence submitted supports the conclusion that a potential violation of the Act has occurred. From the outset, the Department must consider whether it is an expenditure covered by the MCFA. The yard sign specifically states "Elect Michael Coll Mayor of Grand Ledge" which uses words of express advocacy as defined by the Act. MCL 169.206(2)(j). Because it urges voters to vote for you using words of express advocacy and was published by your committee, the signs are covered by the gambit of the Act and must include the paid for by statement outlined under section 47. MCL 169.206(2)(j). However, the signs have completely omitted the required paid for by statement. Since this phrase is absent, the evidence supports the conclusion that a potential violation has occurred.

After reaching this conclusion, the Act requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further violation by using informal methods [,]" if it finds that "there may

be reason to believe that a violation ... has occurred [.]" MCL 169.215(10). The objective of an informal resolution is "to correct the violation or prevent a further violation [.]" *Id*.

Given this, the Department concludes that a formal warning is a sufficient resolution to the complaint and is hereby advising you that MCL 169.247(1) and R 169.36(2) require you to print a complete and accurate identification statement on all campaign materials, consisting of the phrase "paid for by" followed by the full name and address of your committee.

Note that all printed materials referencing you or your candidacy produced in the future must include this identification statement. For all materials currently in circulation, the paid for by statement must be corrected. If this information has been included in your materials and you wish to rebut the Department's conclusion, you must respond in writing to the Department within 15 business days of the date of this letter otherwise the Department will treat the complaint as resolved.

Please be advised that this notice has served to remind you of your obligation under the Act to identify your printed matter and may be used in future proceedings as evidence that tends to establish a knowing violation of the Act. A knowing violation is a misdemeanor offense and may merit referral to the Attorney General for enforcement action. MCL 169.247(6), 215(10).

When I realized my signs did not have the required statement, I printed labels and placed one on every sign I have in place. My understanding was that doing so would bring me into compliance with the requirement and that there was no specific size requirement for the disclosure. I rode around town and verified this afternoon that those notices were still present on every sign, including the one in Mr. Gillespie's photo. Those labels read "Paid for by the Committee to Elect Michael Coll, 102 Ingersoll Street, Grand Ledge, MI 48837". If it is necessary for the notice to be larger, please advise what correction would be acceptable and I will immediately remove all signs and make the appropriate modification.

Regarding my election committee paperwork, I personally visited the Elections Clerk at the Eaton County Courthouse before filing my nominating petitions in Grand Ledge, and I was advised that as I was running for the same office (Mayor) as when I filed that paperwork in 2017, and that none of the information has changed, I was not required to complete another form and my "Committee" remained validly registered. If that was erroneous information, please let me know and I'll go back to the Courthouse and file the necessary update or new form.

I have attached several photos of signs which show the label with my identifying information. Can you please confirm:

1) Whether or not this label meets the requirement or, if not, advise of how large I must make the notice. I find no reference to size in the paragraphs cited in Mr. Gillespie's complaint other than a statement that secretary of state can specify that, but there is no specific guidance provided that I can see. Based on that, I believe Mr. Gillespie's allegations are unsubstantiated. If these signs are NOT in compliance, I will have them removed prior to COB today and will make the necessary adjustments before replacing them. Please advise. The labels read:

2) Was the information received from Eaton County Board of Elections that I am NOT required to provide an update candidate filing form since I am still running the same office and that no information has changed from my 2017 submission accurate? If that information was erroneous, I will file an updated form by week's end. As previously stated, I personally visited the Election Office during a break in jury duty before filing my nominating petitions and was advised that my "committee" was still legal valid and registered and that no further action was required.

Dear Mr. Coll:

The Department of State (Department) has finished investigating the formal complaint alleging you have violated MCL 169.247 of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA) by failing to include a complete and correct identification statement on certain campaign-related materials.

The complaint was submitted to the Department by Brett Gillespie on October 7, 2019 and alleges that you have distributed yard signs that did not include a proper paid for by statement. A picture of the yard signs is included with the complaint. The complaint also alleges that you have failed to maintain your statement of organization with updated information as required by section 24. Mr. Gillespie also included a copy of your statement of organization filed in 2017.

By email dated October 14, 2019, you responded and indicated that prior to the complaint being filed with the Department you realized that the signs did not have the required paid for by statement. You indicated that you printed labels and placed one on every sign that you were able to locate. The labels contained the full mailing address of your committee. In terms of the reports, you indicated that you were on a reporting waiver and asked the Eaton County Clerk's Office whether you needed to refile or amend your statement of organization. You stated that the Clerk's office told you that you did not need to update your records given that nothing had changed. With your response to the complaint, you submitted pictures of the yard signs.

The Department notified Mr. Gillespie of his right to file a rebuttal statement via letter dated October 22, 2019. To date, the Department has not received a rebuttal.

The MCFA and corresponding administrative rules require a person who produces printed material that relates to an election include the phrase "Paid for by [name and address of the person who paid for the item]." MCL 169.247(1), R 169.36(2). A knowing violation constitutes a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000.00, imprisonment for up to 93 days, or both. MCL 169.247(6).

Additionally, section 24 requires candidates to file a statement of organization with the appropriate filing official listed in section 17 of the Act. MCL 169.224(1). The statement of organization is required to be amended upon the changing of information. MCL 169.224(4). A person who fails to file a statement of organization shall pay a late filing fee of \$10.00 for each business day the statement remains not filed not exceed \$300.00. MCL 169.224(1).

Upon review, the evidence submitted does not support the conclusion that a potential violation of section 47 has occurred. From the outset, the Department must consider whether it is an expenditure covered by the MCFA. The yard sign specifically states "Elect Michael Coll Mayor of Grand Ledge" which uses words of express advocacy as defined by the Act. MCL 169.206(2)(j). Because it urges voters to vote for you using words of express advocacy and was published by your committee, the signs are covered by the ambit of the Act and must include the paid for by statement outlined under section 47. MCL 169.206(2)(j). You have indicated that prior to the complaint being filed, you became aware of the missing identification statement and attempted to correct it immediately. You submitted photographs of the identification statement on your signs, and the Department is satisfied that you are in compliance with the law.

Second, the Department also concludes that there is insufficient evidence to support the conclusion that a potential violation of section 24 has occurred. Section 24 requires you to maintain your statement of organization and keep updated your committee information. Additionally, because you are on a reporting waiver, you are not required to file reports with the County Clerk until you have spent or received in excess of \$1,000. In the absence of evidence to the contrary, it appears that your statement of organization is updated with the most accurate information and no violation is present.

Accordingly, the Department concludes that there is insufficient evidence to support the conclusion that a potential violation has occurred. The Department's file on the matter is closed and will be posted to its website in accordance with MCL 169.215.
