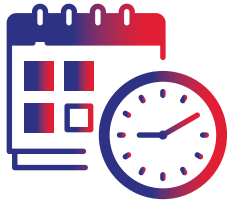
# Early Voting

Every community in Michigan now offers at least 9 days of early, in-person voting for statewide and federal elections!



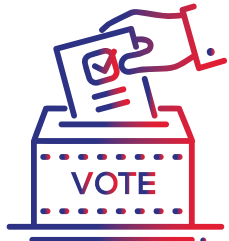
## What is early voting?

Early voting allows voters to cast a ballot in person before an election in an experience similar to voting at a polling place on Election Day. At early voting sites, voters are issued a ballot to complete, and can then insert them directly into a tabulator.



## When can I vote early?

The early voting period takes place for a minimum of nine consecutive days, ending on the Sunday before an election. Communities may decide to provide additional days of early voting, up to 28 days total. Early voting is available for all statewide and federal elections. Communities may also choose to provide early voting for local elections.



## Where can I vote early?

Early voting sites are like polling places open to voters during the early voting period. Voters in every city and township in Michigan will have access to an early voting site to cast their ballot early and in person. Early voting site locations and information will be available 60 days prior to Election Day at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote).
