

Military Voting Rights

Those serving overseas should be able to participate fully in our democracy without significant barriers or obstacles. Special services are currently provided to assist military voters' participation in elections. Recent legislative efforts in Michigan have made voting even easier for those who serve our country.

Register to vote

- **Register or check the status** of your voter registration at Michigan.gov/Vote.
- **You can also register by downloading and completing** the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) from the Federal Voting Assistance Program at **FVAP.gov**.

Request your ballot

Request an absentee ballot be sent to you by email, fax or regular mail.

- **Download** the FPCA from **FVAP.gov**.
 - **Fill it out** and check the box to indicate how you want to receive your ballot.
 - **Submit the FPCA** to your local clerk by postal mail, fax or email.
- **Visit Michigan.gov/Vote** to check the status of your requested ballot and view your ballot ahead of time.

Cast your vote and submit your ballot

- **Return your ballot by regular mail** as soon as possible so it's postmarked by Election Day and received within six days of the election.
- **Under a constitutional amendment** passed by Michigan voters in 2022, ballots from military and overseas voters that are postmarked on or before Election Day and **received within six days of Election Day** will be considered timely received.
