

# Preregistration to vote



Starting this year, 16- and 17-year-old Michigan residents can preregister to vote under state law. Preregister online, by mail, or automatically at the Secretary of State's office when applying for a Graduated Driver's License.

Once preregistered, Michigan teens will be automatically registered to vote when they turn 17.5 – the state's eligible voter registration age.

Young people who preregister can vote by absentee ballot or in person at an early voting site as long as they will be 18 on or before Election Day.

## To preregister to vote in Michigan, you must:

- Be a Michigan resident
- Be at least 16 years of age
- Be a United States citizen
- Not be currently serving a sentence in jail or prison
