



Veteran Designation Application



Military veterans from any branch of the U.S. armed forces with an honorable or under honorable conditions (general) discharge may have a veteran designation printed on their Michigan driver's license or state identification card.

Add the veteran designation by mail or [schedule a visit](#) to a Secretary of State office.

To apply by mail, complete this application and mail it with your veteran documentation, renewal notice (if renewing), and payment (if applicable) to: *Michigan Department of State, Internal Services Section, 7064 Crowner Dr, Lansing, MI 48918.* Make any check or money order payable to the State of Michigan.

Veteran documentation

A copy of your DD-214 form must be included with this application. Other documentation may be accepted in lieu of a DD-214. Photocopies of original documents are accepted. Any veteran documentation enclosed with your application will not be returned and will be destroyed. Visit Michigan.gov/SOS for more information about the veteran designation and a list of acceptable documents.

Fees

During renewal: if you are adding the veteran designation when renewing your driver's license or state ID, pay only your normal renewal fee (and late fee, if applicable). Please refer to your renewal notice for your total fee.

Up to 60 days after renewal: you may request a no-fee correction at a branch office to add the veteran designation.

Any other time: a corrected card fee is due to add the veteran designation. The fee is determined by the type of card you are correcting. **There is no fee to correct a standard state ID.** For other card types, use the corrected card fee table to determine your fee.

Automatic voter registration

Under Michigan law, eligible residents are automatically registered to vote when conducting a driver's license or state ID card transaction with the Secretary of State unless they choose to opt out. If you are already a registered Michigan voter, you may skip this section.

To be eligible to register to vote, you must be a US citizen, at least 17.5 years old (18 years old when you vote), a MI resident (at the time you register), and a resident of your city or township for at least 30 days (when you vote). If you're already registered, checking the box won't cancel your registration or stop your registration address from being updated.
