

Overseas Military Voting

Those serving overseas must be able to participate fully in our democracy without significant barriers or obstacles. Special services are currently provided to assist military voters' participation in elections. New efforts are underway to make voting even easier for those who serve our country.

Register to vote

Register or check the status of your voter registration at **Michigan.gov/Vote**.

- You can also register by **downloading and completing** the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) from the Federal Voting Assistance Program at **FVAP.gov**.

Request your ballot

Request an absentee ballot be sent to you by email, fax or regular mail.

- **Download** the FPCA from **FVAP.gov**.
 - ✓ **Fill it out** and check the box to indicate how you want to receive your ballot.
 - ✓ **Submit the FPCA** to your local clerk by postal mail, fax or email.
- **Visit Michigan.gov/Vote** to check the status of your requested ballot and view your ballot ahead of time.

Mail your completed ballot ASAP

Return your ballot by regular mail as soon as possible so it's received by Election Day.
