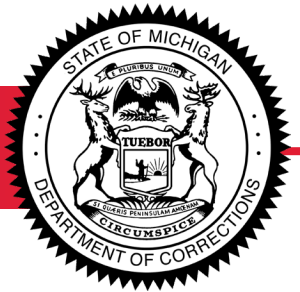




Returning Citizens You can vote!



According to Michigan state law:

If you are at least 18 years old, a U.S. citizen and a resident of Michigan, **you can vote.**

If you have a past conviction, **you can vote.**

If you are on parole, **you can vote.**

If you are on probation, **you can vote.**

If you are in or out of jail waiting to be sentenced, **you can vote.**

Eligible citizens can register to vote online through Oct. 24, or in person at their city or township clerk's office until 8 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 8.
