

# Michigan Department of State Certificate of Scrapping for

<b>Box #1</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Registered, Abandoned, Scrap Vehicle/Vessel <input type="checkbox"/> Unregistered, Abandoned, Scrap Vehicle/Vessel
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*Please note: Vehicle includes motor vehicles, ORVs, and snowmobiles. Vessel includes watercraft.*

**A Certificate of Scrapping** transfers ownership of an abandoned, scrapped vehicle/vessel. To complete this form:

- Box 1: Enter the vehicle/vessel registration status in Box 1 above.
- Box 2: Enter the VIN/HIN/Serial Number, year, make, model, and body style. **This information must correspond to what was entered into LEIN when the vehicle/vessel was taken into custody.**
- Box 3: Enter the law enforcement agency having custody of the vehicle/vessel and the vehicle/vessel's condition.
- Box 4: Enter the towing agency, used vehicle parts dealer, or scrap metal processor to whom the law enforcement agency releases the *vehicle* OR enter the towing service to whom the law enforcement agency releases the *vessel*.
- Box 5: Sign and date the form to certify compliance with Section 252b or Sections 80130g, 81151, and 82161 2014 PA 549.
- Box 6: Enter new owner information for the **Reassignment of Certification of Scrapping** – to be filled out by the towing agency, used vehicle parts dealer, scrap metal processor, automotive recycler, or foreign salvage vehicle dealer if the vehicle/vessel is sold.

*Please note: If the vehicle/vessel is registered or titled in Michigan, the owner of record as kept by the Secretary of State has 20 days from the date of the notice sent by the Michigan Department of State to redeem the vehicle/vessel. If the owner does not redeem the vehicle/vessel within 10 days, the secured party of record may redeem the vehicle/vessel by paying applicable fees and accrued charges to the custodian. If the registered abandoned scrap **vehicle** is not redeemed within 20 days, the law enforcement agency may release it to a towing service, used or secondhand vehicle parts dealer, scrap metal processor, automotive recycler, or foreign salvage vehicle dealer. Or in the case of a registered abandoned scrap **vessel**, the law enforcement or towing agency may release it to a scrap metal processor or landfill operator. Unregistered or untitled vehicles/vessels may be released immediately.*
