Whereas a 2019 Tax Rate Request in excess of the general Property Tax Limitation Act limitation would not be authorized by law.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kalamazoo Board of Commissioners hereby approves the 2019 Tax Rate Request from Oshtemo Township only up to general Property Tax Limitation Act limitation, authorized by law, being:
