RESOLUTION

STURGIS DISTRICT LIBRARY BOARD

At a special meeting of the Library Board of the Sturgis District Library held at the Sturgis District Library, 255 North Street, Sturgis, Michigan 49091, at 5:15 p.m. on Tuesday the 3rd of September, 2019.

PRESENT: Mary Beth Brenneman, Betty Ross, Frank Kalasky, Jill Bobalik, Carol Wallman, and Beth Bond

ABSENT: John Polzin, Gina Whitehead.

The following resolution was offered by Member Frank Kalasky and seconded by Mary Beth Brenneman.

WHEREAS, the Sturgis District Library (the "Library") was established as a district library effective May 1, 2006, pursuant to the Sturgis District Library Agreement between the City of Sturgis, Sturgis Township, Fawn River Township, and Sherman Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the District Library Establishment Act, Act No. 24 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1989, as amended ("Act 24"), the Board is authorized to levy a tax upon all taxable property within the Sturgis District Library district (the District"), provided that the districtwide tax is authorized by the voters of the district; and

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2016, the electors of the District authorized the Board to levy a districtwide property tax in an amount not to exceed 1.1 mills to provide funds for district library purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized by Act 24 to adopt the budget for the Library and to levy a districtwide property tax as approved by district voters in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted a public hearing on the proposed budget for the fiscal year running October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, after giving public notice thereof in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it will levy a districtwide tax of 1.0981 mills and adopt the budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the total amount of \$509,000

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sturgis District Library Board:

1. The Board hereby adopts the Sturgis District Library budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 as presented by the Director (a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A) in the total amount of \$806,110

2. The Board appropriates the following sums for fiscal year 2019-2020 for District Library purposes as set forth below:

3. Pursuant to Act 24, the Board hereby levies on December 1, 2019, a property tax upon all taxable real and tangible personal property within the district of the Sturgis District Library in the amount of 1.0981 mills (\$1.0981 per \$1,000) on the taxable value of such property, as finally equalized, to provide funds for district library purposes.

4. The Board hereby certifies that the millage to be levied on all taxable property in the District has been reduced, if necessary, to comply with Article 9, Section 31 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and that the millage to be levied has also been reduced, if necessary, to comply with MCLA 211.24e and 211.34.

5. The Library Director is hereby authorized and directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution and the 2019 Tax Rate Request on Michigan Department of Treasury Form L-4029 to the County Clerk, the County Equalization Department, and to each Township and City Clerk included in the District.
