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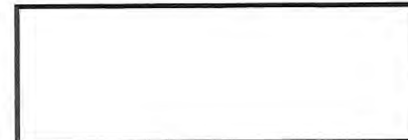




Not more than ten days after public hearing, a taxing unit may approve the levy of an additional millage rate equal to or less than the proposed additional millage rate that was published and on which a public hearing has been held.



The following resolution was offered by Member Mary Beth Brenneman and seconded by John Polzin.

WHEREAS, the Sturgis District Library (the "Library") was established as a district library effective May 1, 2006, pursuant to the Sturgis District Library Agreement between the City of Sturgis, Sturgis Township, Fawn River Township, and Sherman Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the District Library Establishment Act, Act No. 24 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1989, as amended ("Act 24"), the Board is authorized to levy a tax upon all taxable property within the Sturgis District Library district (the District"), provided that the districtwide tax is authorized by the voters of the district; and

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2016, the electors of the District authorized the Board to levy a districtwide property tax in an amount not to exceed 1.1 mills to provide funds for district library purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized by Act 24 to adopt the budget for the Library and to levy a districtwide property tax as approved by district voters in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted a public hearing on the proposed budget for the fiscal year running October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, after giving public notice thereof in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it will levy a districtwide tax of 1.0981 mills and adopt the budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 in the total amount of \$812,250.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sturgis District Library Board:

1. The Board hereby adopts the Sturgis District Library budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 as presented by the Director (a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A) in the total amount of \$812,250

2. The Board appropriates the following sums for fiscal year 2020-2021 for District Library purposes as set forth below:

3. Pursuant to Act 24, the Board hereby levies on December 1, 2020, a property tax upon all taxable real and tangible personal property within the district of the Sturgis District Library in the amount of 1.0981 mills (\$1.0981 per \$1,000) on the taxable value of such property, as finally equalized, to provide funds for district library purposes.

4. The Board hereby certifies that the millage to be levied on all taxable property in the District has been reduced, if necessary, to comply with Article 9, Section 31 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and that the millage to be levied has also been reduced, if necessary, to comply with MCLA 211.24e and 211.34.

5.
