The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received Resolution Number 2018-032 from the City of Saginaw regarding the revocation of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-12-0019, issued to James Bricault, located at 126 N Franklin Street in the City of Saginaw.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate number 3-12-0019 as approved by the City of Saginaw and the resolution will be filed for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
